NOTIFICATION

MERITORIOUS SCHOLARSHIP (2026-27)

Swami Vivekanand Subharti University, in its endeavor to impart quality education based on values and innovation, has launched several schemes to encourage students to excel in their respective fields. *Meritorious Scholarship* is one such scheme which aims to create a significant impact on the delivery of knowledge and skills. This scheme shall cover a large number of students who are not in receipt of any financial assistance from other Government/Private agencies.

The Hon'ble Vice-Chancellor is pleased to announce **Programme-wise Scholarships**, superseding all previous orders relating to Meritorious Scholarships based on fixed odd and even semester fee. However, calculation of the scholarship amount shall be based on the following pre-conditions, after due recommendation of the Principal/Head of Department (HOD):

1. The scholarship shall be applicable only to students who are not availing any other scholarship from any Government/Private/Non-Government organization.
2. Only one type of scholarship, whichever is higher, shall be permitted even if a student is eligible for more than one scholarship announced by the University.
3. The scholarship shall be applicable only for the current academic year, provided the student submits the full applicable fee within the stipulated period and applies for scholarship-on-Scholarship **Format-I**.
4. The percentage of marks used for scholarship criteria shall be the same as used for eligibility for admission.
5. Scholarship, if granted, shall be disbursed through banking channel only. Disbursement shall be made only after submission of complete academic year fee, i.e., fee deposition of both semesters.
6. If a student wishes to avail scholarship in the forthcoming years (after 1st year), he/she must apply afresh on **Scholarship Format-II**, subject to fulfilment of the following mandatory conditions:
 - a) Attained First Division in first attempt.
 - b) Not involved in any act of indiscipline.
 - c) No pending dues.
 - d) Attendance as per University rules.
7. The percentage of scholarship granted in the first year shall be considered as the maximum for the succeeding year, if applied for. However, if the student's performance (marks %) drops, the scholarship amount/percentage shall decrease accordingly or may be withdrawn if the above conditions are not met.

8. If a student submits complete fee for both semesters before the due date of the first/odd semester, as a special case, the student shall be entitled to a **10% one-time special scholarship** in addition to the eligible scholarship. This shall be applicable only for semester-based courses and not for annual courses.
9. In case of withdrawal of admission before completion of the programme, the scholarship amount, if granted, shall be refunded to the University.

VI. Students who are in differently able category

- Exemption from payment of Annual Tuition Fee in respect of Persons with Benchmark Disabilities.

The Persons with disabilities shall be given concession / free ship in annual tuition fee prescribed in respective programme of studies (UG) for admission depending on Benchmark disability. This exemption shall be available only to such persons who enclose with the application form, necessary certificate from a competent authority in support of their claim of disability. Only such persons would be eligible for concession who suffer from not less than 40 per cent of relevant disability.

The details of concession given are (valid proof essential);


