Module 2.2 – FOUNDATION OF BIOETHICS

An AETCOM class on module 2.2 for the topic – “*Foundation of Bioethics*” was scheduled on 03/02/2024 in Lecture theatre 1 by the Department of Forensic Medicine under the guidance of AETCOM Committee, Subharti Medical College, SVSU, Meerut.

The session started with introduction on basic understanding of Bioethics, its origin and history and progressed with discussion on the principles of bioethics namely *Autonomy, beneficence, non-maleficence and justice*. The class was made interactive with 2-way discussion on perception of students on the applications of principles of bioethics in daily routine practise of a health care worker. The facilitator then discussed multiple instances of application of principles of bioethics in health care and explained them with suitable examples.

The students were also enquired of their personal experiences where they have experienced the applicability of these principles by professionals during the practice of medicine. The students also enquired about their queries with the facilitator and cleared their doubts.

The session was facilitated by Dr. Abhishek Sangal, Professor, Department of Forensic Medicine, Subharti Medical College, SVSU, Meerut. The session was attended by a total of 75 students of MBBS 2022 batch. (Attendance list attached).

AETCOM REPORT MBBS 2022 Batch

Module 2.4 – WORKING IN A HEALTH CARE TEAM

A class on AETCOM module 2.4 entitled – "Working in a Health Care Team" was conducted in Lecture theatre – 2 by the Department of Forensic Medicine under the guidance of AETCOM Committee, Subharti Medical College, SVSU, Meerut. Two classes were scheduled to discuss the topics on 02/03/2024 and 16/03/2024.

The 1st class (**AETCOM module 2.4 A and 2.4 B**) began by introducing the concept of Team work in healthcare and highlighting its significance in treatment of a patient. The facilitator talked about the need of health care teams, their key members, roles and responsibilities of each member in the team and benefits and challenges faced during the team work.

The facilitator also discussed various case scenarios highlighting the effect of successful collaboration for better patient outcome. The students were enquired about specific strategies for effective collaboration and were detailed about the necessity for training and development of team work during health care of a patient.

Following the brief introductory session, the students were further divided in small batches (group of 10) and were sent for a 'tag-along session' in different clinical departments at Chhatrapati Shivaji Subharti Hospital, Meerut. The students were asked to observe the working of clinicians, residents, nursing staff, paramedics and other associated staff present in their respective clinical wards. The faculty appointed to each group practically demonstrated the importance of team work in their daily routine treatment. The hierarchical and planned structure in health care service helped the students in understanding the need of working in a team especially during emergencies.

In the subsequent class for **AETCOM Module 2.5 C** (scheduled on 16.03.2024), the students were asked to detail and discuss their observations and experiences with other groups. The students heartily interacted and even asked their queries from the facilitator. At the end of the session, the facilitator requested each group to submit their observations in form of reflective writing in the department.

Both the sessions were facilitated by Dr. Surabhi Gupta, Professor & head, Department of Pharmacology, SMC, SVSU and Dr. Abhishek Sangal, Professor, Department of Forensic Medicine,



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SMC, SVSU, Meerut in collaboration with faculty members from all the clinical departments. Both the sessions were attended by 86 and 83 students of MBBS 2022 batch on 02/03/2024 and 16/03/2024 respectively.

Use projective techniques to gain deeper insights into personal strengths, values, and areas for growth. Employ these techniques to understand team dynamics and individual differences, fostering better collaboration. Apply findings from projective techniques to refine leadership styles and improve interpersonal skills.

Seek Professional Guidance: Work with a psychologist or trained professional to administer and interpret projective techniques. Integrate Findings: Use insights from projective techniques to inform personal development plans, team strategies, and leadership approaches. 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

Objective of the Activity: to clear the concept how to 'How to Face Camera' & to motivate the students to create video content.






OBJECTIVE


