**Objectives of the Event:**

2. **To raise awareness about ethical living as part of the Vigilance Awareness–2025 initiative** conducted in collaboration with the Department of Education and the Ambedkar Chair.
3. **To utilise the pedagogy of street theatre (Nukkad Natak)** to convey key messages on transparency, accountability, and moral conduct in public and private life.
4. **To encourage participatory learning**, enabling students to express social concerns through performance-based activities.
5. **To sensitise the academic community** on the importance of maintaining integrity in day-to-day actions, decision-making processes, and professional environments.

**Description of the Event:**

The Department of Education, Faculty of Education, Swami Vivekanand Subharti University, in collaboration with the Dr. Ambedkar Chair, organised an extensive and impactful Nukkad Natak titled “**Vigilance inMotion: Street Play for Ethical Living**” on **Wednesday, 5 November 2025**. Conducted from **11:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m.** within the **university campus**, the programme formed a central component of Vigilance Awareness Week, a national initiative aimed at reinforcing public consciousness around integrity, accountability, and responsible citizenship.

The event commenced with the support and encouragement of **Prof. (Dr.) Pramod Kumar Sharma**, Hon’ble Vice-Chancellor, Swami Vivekanand Subharti University and **Prof. (Dr.) Shalya Raj**, Chief Executive Officer, Swami Vivekanand Subharti University, who acknowledged the academic importance of such value-based activities. They appreciated the students’ willingness to participate actively in a social awareness campaign that extends beyond classroom learning.

A distinguished panel of university authorities and academic leaders graced the occasion, including **Prof. (Dr.) Indira Singh**, Head Department of Education, F.O.E, SVSU and **Prof. (Dr.) Anoj Raj**, Chair Professor of the Dr. Ambedkar Chair, Swami Vivekanand Subharti University. Their presence added academic strength to the initiative, demonstrating the institution’s collective commitment to fostering ethical sensibilities among students. Several other esteemed faculty members from the Department of Education also attended, offering continuous guidance and moral support.

The event was meticulously coordinated under the supervision of **Dr. Reshu Rani**, Assistant Professor, Department of Education, F.O.E, SVSU who played a pivotal role in conceptualising the programme and guiding students throughout the preparation phase. Her direction ensured smooth logistical arrangements, well-structured sequencing of performances, and active engagement of the audience. Under her mentorship, the students rehearsed intensively, refining their delivery and deepening their understanding of the social issues they intended to portray.

The street play was performed by students of the **B.El.Ed 1st, 3rd, 5th, and 7th semesters**, whose active engagement added both diversity and depth to the presentation, reflecting their commitment to promoting social awareness.

The narrative highlighted modern threats such as online fraud, phishing scams, identity theft, cyber bullying, data breaches, offline theft, and various forms of corruption that continue to affect individuals and communities. Through strong characterization and relatable scenarios, the performers conveyed how ordinary citizens often fall prey to these issues due to negligence, lack of awareness, or blind trust.

The play emphasized the idea that vigilance is not merely a governmental responsibility but a collective social duty. The students illustrated how awareness, alertness, and ethical behaviour can significantly reduce the frequency of fraud and malpractice. The dialogues further encouraged the audience to remain cautious in their digital interactions, demonstrating examples of safe online practices, verification of information, and responsible use of social media.

Throughout the performance, students used creative elements such as slogans, rhythmic claps, street-style chanting, and coordinated movements to draw the attention of passers-by and keep the audience

meaningfully engaged. Their enactment effectively bridged educational theory with real-life application, turning complex civic issues into comprehensible and relatable content for all viewers.

Participants gained a deeper understanding of the importance of ethical practices and vigilance in personal, academic, and social contexts.
