Vocalists and Instrumentalists

1) Auto Tune

It alters the pitch of a singing voice to make everyone sound perfectly in tune. When used properly, it's subtle enough that it can't be detected.

2) Digital Audio Workstation (DAW)

A digital audio workstation (DAW) is an electronic device or software application used to record, edit, and produce sound files.

DAWs generally have access to libraries of sounds and are used to create electronic music from scratch. Commercial DAWs, can be hardware integrated into computers.

3) Audio Plugins and Virtual Studio Technology (VST)

Plugins are basically hardware or software that can be "plugged in" to DAWs to enhance their functionality. Generally, plugins fall into the categories of audio signal processing, analysis, or sound synthesis. Typical plugins include equalization, dynamic range control, reverberation, delay, and virtual instruments.

VST is an audio plugin software interface that integrates software synthesizers and effects units into digital audio workstations

4) Dynamic microphones

These are microphones that convert sound into an electrical signal by means of electromagnetism. They fall into two



categories, moving coil and ribbon microphones. A moving coil capsule: At the back of the transparent membrane you can see the wire coil, which is surrounded by a permanent magnet

Condenser mic are mainly responsible for the clarity of sound in studios. Now a days random artists do purchase condenser mic for their audios and videos which further reduces the cost of working on a project in studios.
