This memorandum of Understanding (hereinafter called as the 'MOU') is entered into on this the 18th day of month October, 2023 by and between

1. **Swami Vivekanand Subharti University**, the First Party represented herein by its **Registrar**.
2. **Institute of Genetics and Plant Experimental Biology**, the Second Party represented herein by the **Director**.

About SVSU

The Swami Vivekanand Subharti University (NAAC 'A" Accredited, established u/s 29/2008 of UGC Act, 1956 (hereinafter referred to 'SVSU'), commenced its academic programmes in 2008. The University is located in Meerut, Uttar Pradesh, India. SVSU is a research-intensive, multi-disciplinary University that shares the values of high-quality teaching within an environment of internationally competitive research.

About IGPEB

Institute of Genetics and Plant Experimental Biology, 111226, p/o Yukari-Yuz; Kebray district, Tashkent region, Uzbekistan was established (by the decision of Academy of Science RUz No.4-23 from 13 February, 1997) joint of two institutes (the decision of Cabinet of Ministers of RUz No.337, July 21st, 1992). They are institute of Genetics and another is the institute of plant experimental biology (created in 1948).

PURPOSE/OBJECTIVES of MOU

In accordance with a mutual desire to promote further cooperation in higher education between Swami Vivekanand Subharti University, Meerut, Uttar Pradesh, India and Institute of Genetics and Plant Experimental Biology, Uzbekistan enter into this formal agreement for the purpose of educational and cultural exchange. The objective of this Memorandum of Understanding is to develop educational cooperation on the basis of equality, reciprocity and mutual benefit as well as to promote relations and mutual understanding between the parties. This MoU aims to build a long term relationship and to develop health and stable arrangement between both the parties.

The two institutions have found it mutually beneficial to initiate the following cooperative activities:

- (1) Exchange of theses, teaching materials, and other scientific and technological literature
- (2) Research collaboration & international collaborative research funding
- (3) Exchange of faculty and scholars for lecturing, advanced studies, and research

- (4) Conduct of joint workshops, symposia, etc. on topics of mutual interest, and
- (5) Exploration of potential student exchanges. (Student exchanges shall require separate written agreements between the parties.)
- (6) Exchange of published academic materials and other information.
- (7) Joint societal need based short term academic programs.
- (8) Sharing the knowledge on modern technology related to smart agriculture, biological system, sustainable natural resource management and other research developmental activities.
- (9) Submission of international joint research proposal to the concerned granting agency of India, Uzbekistan and rest of world.

SCOPE & CO-OPERATION OF WORK UNDER MOU

- The scope of work under MOU will continue with mutual trust, no legal bindings will be invited on either side related to the task.
- Planning, designing and formulation of academic activities will be done with the mutual understanding of both the parties.
- Planning and monitoring of research, any kind of joint collaborative programmes and other functional requirements will be the responsibility of both the parties.
- Both the parties will support each other in case of Faculty and Student Exchange program, updation of course modules as per the industry requirements.
- Data-sharing pertaining to the collaborative research work will be ensured between the parties for official purpose only.
- Both the parties will works to promote capacity building workshop, environmental awareness and gender sensitization programmes and other such activates and may carry the name and logo in its reports/website/any publicity materials on prior permission basis.
- First Party & Second Party believe that collaboration and co-operation between themselves will promote more effective use of each of their resources, and provide each of them with enhanced opportunities.
- The Parties intent to cooperate and focus their efforts on cooperation within area of Skill Based Training, Education, Placement, Industrial Visit, Expert Lecture.
- Both Parties are united by common interests and objectives, and they shall establish co-operation.
- First Party and Second Party co-operation will facilitate effective utilization of the intellectual capabilities.
- The parties shall co-operate with each other and shall as promptly as is responsibly

practical, relevant agreement.

- All the correspondence, official documents and notifications relevant to the implementation of this MoU shall be in English language.

FINANCIAL LIABILITIES

There will be no financial burden on both the parties. In case of student and faculty exchange programmes the cost will be borne by respective participants. Both the organization will work to get funds from funding agencies of respective countries. In case if both the parties are jointly carrying out any international project, the financial terms will be decided by both the parties based on the cost of the project and through separate contract or MOU. Both Parties to obtain all internal approvals, consents, permissions, and licenses of whatsoever nature required.

DURATION AND TERMINATION

This MoU is effective as of the date 20th May 2023 to 19th May 2028 for a period of five years and can be extended in line with the terms and conditions on the agreement of both the parties. This agreement is valid till terminated by either party under mutual understanding. Either party may terminate this agreement at any time by giving ninety (90) days written notice. Course/Projects, which may be undergoing and/or have been undertaken, should be completed before termination of the agreement. Students' interest will not be harm due to this termination. Each party will be bound to maintain that.

AMENDMENT:

Amendment to this agreement can be done with mutual consent of the parties signing such amendment in writing.
