

MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING
For M Tech in Defence Technology

This Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) is entered into 21.05.2022 between Swami Vivekanand Subharti University, Subharti Puram, NH-58, Delhi Haridwar Bypass Road, Meerut-250005 through its Registrar (hereinafter called the "First Party")

SWAMI VIVEKANAND SUBHARTI UNIVERSITY is a multi-disciplinary university that is accredited A by NAAC.

AND

INSTITUTE OF DEFENCE SCIENTISTS AND TECHNOLOGISTS (IDST), through its Chairman, Delhi Branch, CFEES Campus, Brig. S K Mazumdar Marg, Timarpur, Delhi – 110054 through (hereinafter called the "Second Party")

INSTITUTE OF DEFENCE SCIENTISTS AND TECHNOLOGISTS (IDST), a Deemed Academic Institution, recognized by Department of Scientific and Industrial Research (DSIR) of Ministry of Science and Technology,.

WHEREAS DRDO has collaborated with AICTE for the introduction of a Regular M.Tech (Master of Technology, a post graduate degree) Course in Defence Technology having 6 specialized streams for which the syllabi have been published by AICTE.

WHEREAS DRDO has entrusted coordination and conduct of this program at various institutes in the country to IDST as per the defined scope of responsibilities.

WHEREAS the First Party is a reputed University head quartered in the Uttar Pradesh, India providing higher education in most of the branches of knowledge, besides excelling in research in various disciplines in Science & Technology

AND


WHEREAS Second Party makes available the expertise and knowledge of the vast pool of retired DRDO scientists who are still in the prime of their intellectual capabilities, to their parent department and to any credible organization in need of such high quality of personnel and services (scientific/technological).

WHEREAS First Party and the Second Party have a common objective of the development and dissemination of knowledge in the field of Defence Technologies.

NOW, both the said parties collaborate and agree to the terms of this MOU as given hereafter to achieve the objective.

Objective:

This MoU records mutual intent for academic collaboration between First Party and the Second Party for academic progression by providing opportunity to pursue studies and research in the areas of mutual interest. At present, this MOU covers introduction of M. Tech Course in DEFENCE TECHNOLOGY" at the University of First Party.

Terms & Conditions of Admission:

1. That the Second Party shall provide a list of suitable faculty from amongst the Second Party members to deliver talks (Lectures) on those subjects shortlisted by the First Party during Semesters 1 and 2. In case of any shortfall, the Second Party will assist the First Party to arrange the same from DRDO / Public / Private Sector as deemed fit.

The payment to these faculty will be made as per First Party's honorarium / salary policies.

2. That Project & dissertation work of semesters 3 and 4 will be conducted at DRDO lab / DRDO nominated Center of Excellence / DIAT Pune / PSU's / Private Defence Industries by placing the students appropriately in the various labs located all over the country for which the Second Party will assist the First Party appropriately. All other details shall be mutually decided following prevailing Rules and Regulations of the First Party.

3. That the First Party will pay the relevant mutually agreed charges for the services rendered by the Second Party towards the yearly coordination fee.

The financial agreement will be signed separately as when required.

4. That the First Party has agreed to provide admission to students for M Tech Course in Defence Technology. Necessary security clearance needs to be obtained from DRDO HQ before granting admission to students of Foreign Origin / Foreign Nationality.

5. That the First Party shall handle the Admission Process entirely at their end. Further, all administrative and commercial matters related to the conduct of the students during the duration of the course shall be dealt by the First Party.

6. That an apex level Joint Committee will be formed to take the process forward and also examine further areas of cooperation. The recommendations of the Joint Committee on any matter referred to it under this scheme will be placed before the appropriate bodies of the First Party for approval.

7. That a Coordinator on both sides will be appointed to oversee the implementation of MOU. The Second Party will nominate one member as their Coordinator for coordinating the activities.

8. That all the necessary approvals and permissions from appropriate statutory and regulatory authorities will be the responsibility of the First Party.

9. That there shall be periodic review meetings amongst, Chairman of Second Party and two coordinators to focus on syllabus coverage by faculty and monitoring / enabling if there is any short fall.

Approval:

10. That this MoU is subject to the approval of the competent authorities of both parties and also subject to the relevant laws of the land. The approval would be deemed to be in place once the MoU is signed.

Date of Effect:

11. That the MoU takes effect from the date it is signed by the authorized representative of the parties and will be in force for a period of Two years after which it would be reviewed through a joint consultation.

Commercial Terms:

12. That the First Party is liable to pay Honorarium to the Faculty for lectures / examinations / guidance as per University rules and Outstation travelling and lodging boarding / local conveyance etc. at actual for the services rendered.

That the First Party shall pay to the Second Party such charges as may be mutually decided.

Modification:

13. That the terms of the MoU may be modified, if and when required with the required consent of both the parties.

Termination:

14. That either party shall be entitled to terminate this MoU by providing the other party with three calendar months advance notice. The termination of the MoU, for whatever reasons, will not affect the rights of a party, which may have secured as on the date of termination and will further not affect any rights, which specifically or by their nature survive the termination of this MoU.



15.Disputes:

That in the event of any disputes or differences arising between the parties hereto either during the substance of this MOU or afterwards relating to rights and obligations of the parties hereto, or in any way relating to this MOU that the same be referred to the Hon'ble Vice Chancellor of the First Party, whose decision shall be binding upon both the parties.

Not with standing, in case of termination, the Second Party will provide its committed services for the ongoing semester and students already enrolled for any programme shall be permitted to complete the programme.

In agreement of the above objectives, terms and conditions, this Memorandum of Understanding is hereby signed by the below mentioned parties on this 21.05.2022.
