
In order to encourage closer Research ties, **Swami Vivekanand Subharti University (Part A)**, a NAAC 'A' grade accredited University established under section 2(f) of the University Grant Commission (U.G.C.) Act, 1956 vide U.P. Act No.29 of 2008, as passed by Uttar Pradesh Legislature and **International Buddhist Confederation (Part B)**, an International Buddhist Organization founded in 2011, agreed on cooperation to collaborate in areas of interest and benefit to both institutions. This agreement will serve as a general framework for cooperation between the two institutions and is intended to facilitate discussion of more specific programs of collaboration. In particular, the two institutions agree:


1. To promote education and research activities about Buddha, Buddhism, and Peace.
2. To support Tathagat Buddha Chair established by Part-A.
3. Preservation, promotion and development of tangible and intangible heritage and traditions of minority and isolated Buddhist communities in India.
4. To support the exchange of staff and volunteers.
5. To work for the preservation and development of Buddhist art and culture.
6. To cooperate on both academic and technological aspects in order to achieve goal no. 1.
7. Part-A is responsible for providing infrastructure and Research Personnel as and when required to Party B on mutually agreed terms and conditions to be decided from time to time.
8. Providing a united and common platform for all Buddhist traditions and organizations.
9. Fostering interfaith understanding through dialogue exchange and collaboration.
10. Ensuring that the path and practice of Dhamma retain social relevance in a changing society while honoring its traditions and practices.
11. Exploration, identification, conservation, and preservation of Buddhist holy sites, relics, heritage, practices, traditions, and Buddhist cultural assets worldwide.
12. To promote practice and observance of the principles of Buddhism.
13. To establish and maintain or assist in the establishment and maintenance of such institutions of learning as may be necessary for the study of Buddhism.
14. Facilitating constant dialogue between Buddhism and modern science.
15. The tenure of this Memorandum of Understanding will be 5 years from the date of signing. However, it can be terminated anytime with the consent of both the parties.
16. Terms not covered herewith, if any, will be discussed and settled on mutual agreement by both parties.


A designated person at each institution shall oversee and facilitate the implementation of this agreement in cooperation with other appropriate administrators at the respective institutions.
