



## MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

#### 1 PREAMBLE

Recognising the mutual benefits to be gained through a cooperative program promoting scholarly activities between **SMP Govt. Girls PG College, Madhavpuram, Meerut (UP)** and **Faculty of Law & Department of Computer Applications, Swami Vivekanand Subharti University, Meerut (UP)** the specified above enter into this Memorandum of Understanding on the terms set out below.

#### 2 PURPOSE

2.1 The purpose of the present Memorandum of Understanding is to foster upon mutual exchange of ideas and knowledge to have a just and equitable society with highest level of professional excellence. Both the institutions will have to work as follows for the realization of the objective.

(A) SMP Govt. Girls PG College will provide personality and grooming classes which will prove to be an additional feature to the candidates of professional degrees like BALLB, BCA and MCA.

(B) Faculty of Law will initiate dialogues on the contemporary topics related to women empowerment highlighting the know-how of laws intact to the safety of women. The Department of Computer Application will work upon the enhancement of computer

literacy amongst the students providing a sound technological hand which has become the utmost necessary in today's digital era. These efforts will prove to be helpful for strengthening and empowering girl students coming from remote villages and rural background.

For the attainment of the objective and the desirables 2.1 (A) and (B) the stakeholders from both the institutions will sit together and prepare the modalities of the execution for the attainment of the objectives.

2.2 This is the responsibility of both the stakeholders to evaluate the progress at least once in six months for the better outcome. This collaboration is to provide a framework by which the parties may in future undertake joint activities together, which may include:

- (a) Development of the collaborative efforts for students, research scholars and faculty members to explore multi-disciplinary know-how to enhance their academics and professional compatibility in the professional arena.
- (b) To build an exchange programme for the communication skills strengthening, women empowerment through law awareness specifically for women fraternity and computer literacy.
- (c) Organisation of joint academic activities, such as expert talks, conferences, seminars, practical aspects, symposia and lectures for the benefit of students, research scholars and faculty members as well.
- (d) To share the research resources for the benefit of research scholars, students and faculty members as well.
- (e) To exchange faculty members so as to deliver scheduled talks on contemporary topics.
- (f) To provide consultancy to both the institutions for the betterment and progress of the students.

### **3 STATUS**

This Memorandum does not create any legal binding obligations or rights between the parties.

### **4 TERM OF THIS MEMORANDUM**

- 4.1 The MoU is aligned with NEP 2020 which gives emphasis over the local collaboration efforts and the usage of available resources for mutual benefits.
- 4.2 The faculty members of each institution while performing any duty in completion of this MoU will be considered on duty. Except this, there will not be any financial application and also no transportation facility shall be arranged by either of the parties. It will be

one's own responsibility to cater to the assignment.

- 4.3 This Memorandum commences on the date specified on the last page of this document, and remains in effect for three years. The parties may renew this MOU for additional term by mutual consent.
- 4.4 Either party may terminate this Memorandum at any time by notifying the other party at least one month in advance of the proposed date of termination.
- 4.4 Termination or expiry of this Memorandum does not affect any legal binding arrangements in effect or continuing following termination or expiry of this Memorandum.

## 5. COORDINATION OF AGREED ACTIVITIES

(A) In order to carry out and fulfil the aims of this Memorandum, each party may appoint a coordinator, who will be responsible for managing the development and conduct of any activities upon which the parties agree.


