2. Introduction of University Career Counselling Cell (UCCC):-

In today's dynamic and competitive world, this choice is often challenging due to multiple influencing factors such as personal interests, financial considerations, academic pathways, and employment opportunities. To guide students at this crucial juncture, the University Career Counselling Cell (UCCC) at **Swami Vivekanand Subharti University** plays a pivotal role in shaping their future.

The UCCC serves as a structured platform to help students assess their skills, interests, aspirations, and strengths, thereby empowering them to make informed career decisions. Career counselling at UCCC goes beyond providing information—it enables students to discover themselves, analyze their strengths and weaknesses, and design a clear execution plan for their professional journey. By offering counselling, skill mapping, and psychometric assessments right from the first year, the Cell ensures that students are aware of their career anchors early and can channel their academic choices accordingly.

Functioning systematically, the UCCC conducts monthly meetings with counsellors from constituent colleges, organizes regular counselling sessions, and facilitates open discussions where students can seek guidance directly from experts. Detailed documentation, monthly activity reports, and bi-annual digital newsletters ensure transparency and dissemination of knowledge to all stakeholders. Further, the UCCC collaborates with the Entrepreneurship Development Cell and Training & Placement Cell to connect students with entrepreneurial opportunities or employment pathways, depending on their aspirations.

The outcomes of these initiatives are evident in clarified career goals, enhanced resume and interview preparedness, identification of further training needs, and most importantly, a boost in students' confidence and self-awareness. UCCC strives not just to provide direction but to nurture a growth mindset, adaptability, and resilience among students—qualities essential for thriving in a rapidly evolving professional landscape.

Thus, the University Career Counselling Cell is not merely a support mechanism but a **guiding force that equips students to transform their potential into success and their aspirations into reality.**

a. Objectives of UCCC :-

- To guide students in making informed career choices through counselling, assessments, and expert guidance.
- To enhance employability by developing skills such as resume writing, interview preparation, and communication.
- To identify and nurture entrepreneurial potential while supporting students seeking employment or higher education.

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- To build self-awareness, confidence, and adaptability for success in a dynamic professional world.
 - To maintain systematic reporting and disseminate career-related outcomes to stakeholders.
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3. Activities Conducted (2024-2025):-

1. **Guest Lecture on Career Opportunities in Financial Sectors**
The AVGSCMC organized a guest lecture on "*Career Opportunities in Financial Sectors*" on **25th March 2025**. The session witnessed the participation of **95 students and 08 faculty members**.

Focus Area: Bridging the gap between academia and industry, with an emphasis on career pathways and professional growth in the financial markets.

2. **Career Counselling Session in Home Science**
The **Department of Home Science** conducted a career counselling session on "*Opportunities in Home Science*" on **28th November 2024**, attended by **23 students and 05 faculty members**.

Focus Area: Student-centric and participative learning, skill development, and *Mission Shakti* initiatives for empowering women's careers.

3. **Two-Day Workshop on Job Opportunities in the Share Market**
The **Faculty of Management and Commerce (FOMC)** organized a **two-day workshop** on "*Job Opportunities in the Share Market*" on **18th-19th November 2024**. The workshop engaged **54 students, 12 faculty members, and 04 staff members**.

Focus Area: Exploring career prospects in the dynamic world of stock markets and the broader financial sector.

4. **Expert Talk on Recent Industry Trends**
The **Polytechnic College** hosted an expert talk on "*Recent Trends in Industry – Requirements, Challenges, and Motivation*" on **18th October 2024**. The event benefitted **90 students and 11 faculty members**.

Focus Area: Enhancing employability through awareness of skill requirements and industry expectations.

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5. **Guest Lecture on Career after Engineering**
The Faculty of Engineering and Technology organized a guest lecture on “*Career after Engineering*” on 7th October 2024, with the active participation of 152 students.

Focus Area: Employment opportunities and career avenues for engineering graduates.

6. **Guest Lecture on Career and Entrepreneurial Skills in Teacher Education**
The Department of Education organized a guest lecture on “*Career and Entrepreneurial Skills: Opportunities and Challenges under NEP 2020 in Teacher Education*” on 24th September 2024. The lecture benefitted 49 students and 14 faculty members.

Focus Area: Entrepreneurial opportunities and career preparedness in the evolving landscape of teacher education.

7. **Workshop on Career Counselling for Law Aspirants**
The Subharti College of Law organized a one-day workshop on “*Career Counselling for Law Aspirants*” on 20th September 2024, attended by 96 students.

8. **Expert Lecture on Career Opportunities in Paramedical Sports**
The Department of Paramedical Sciences conducted an expert lecture on “*Career Opportunities in Paramedical Sports*” on 14th September 2024. The session benefitted an impressive gathering of 264 students.

Focus Area: Expanding career horizons for paramedics in the growing field of sports and allied health services.

9. **Guest Lecture on Trends in the Hospitality Industry**
The Subharti College of Hotel Management organized a guest lecture on “*Current Trends in Shaping the Hospitality Industry Driven by Entrepreneurs*” on 9th September 2024. A total of 43 students participated.

Focus Area: Entrepreneurial innovation and emerging trends redefining careers in the hospitality sector.

4. Feedback & Impact Assessment:-

The activities conducted by the University Career Counselling Cell (UCCC) during the academic session 2024–2025 generated a significant impact on student engagement, career preparedness, and industry awareness. The assessment of feedback and outcomes is summarized below:

a. Student Participation Statistics:-

The counselling sessions, workshops, and guest lectures conducted across various faculties and constituent colleges recorded **high levels of student participation**, with numbers ranging from small, focused groups (23–50 participants) in specialized sessions to large gatherings (90–260 students) in sector-wide discussions. The **Faculty of Engineering & Technology** and **Department of Paramedical Sciences** witnessed the highest attendance, reflecting students' keen interest in exploring post-graduate employability and specialized career opportunities. Overall, the diverse participation indicates that UCCC successfully reached students across different disciplines.

b. Feedback from Students, Alumni, and Recruiters:-

- **Students** expressed appreciation for the practical insights provided by industry experts and faculty mentors. Many highlighted that sessions on financial markets, paramedical opportunities in sports, and entrepreneurship in hospitality gave them clarity on niche career domains. Students also valued the interactive nature of the sessions, where they could raise queries and receive personalized guidance..

c. Analysis of Effectiveness of Programs

The counselling activities of 2024–2025 proved effective in bridging the gap between **academic learning and industry requirements**. Key outcomes include:

- **Clarity of Career Goals:** Students reported improved understanding of career paths in diverse fields such as law, financial markets, home science, engineering, and paramedical sciences.
- **Skill Awareness:** Workshops focusing on stock markets, teacher education under NEP 2020, and hospitality entrepreneurship enhanced student awareness of both conventional and emerging skills.
- **Confidence Building:** Many students acknowledged that interaction with industry professionals boosted their confidence, motivation, and preparedness to face career challenges.
- **Gender Inclusivity:** Initiatives such as *Mission Shakti* in Home Science counselling sessions reflected a strong focus on empowering women students with career guidance.
- **Sustainability of Efforts:** The systematic documentation of activities and consistent involvement of faculty ensured continuity and institutional strengthening of career counselling practices.

Overall, the **impact assessment reveals that UCCC initiatives were well-received, widely attended, and highly effective in guiding students toward making informed career choices**, while also enhancing their employability and confidence.
