GUIDELINES FOR ABSTRACT SUBMISSION

- Abstracts are expected to be limited to 400 words (exclusive of the title and the author's name)
- Abstracts must be in English (Typed, Times New Roman, Font size 12)

The abstract must include:

- Title (less than 50 words), Author's name, Introduction, objectives, Methods, Results, discussions, implications and Conclusion.
- The duration of the presentation will be 7 minutes.
- In case of more than one author, the presenting author's name should be declared (underlined).
- Interventional studies, descriptive studies on different nursing and mid-wifery categories will be accepted. Studies based on PTP, STP, SIM will not be accepted.
- The abstract must be sent via email at nursing@subharti.org

- All posters should be prepared in English
- Layout: portrait (Vertical Orientation)
- Size of poster: 100cmx100cm (1mx1m) and send in pdf form to the above-mentioned email
- It must be self-explanatory

Sight Seeing Places Near Meerut

HASTINAPUR

Hastinapur is a city in the Meerut district in the Indian state of Uttar Pradesh. Hastinapura, described in Hindu texts such as the Mahabharata and the Puranas as the capital of the Kuru Kingdom, is also mentioned in ancient Jain texts. Hastinapur is located on the right bank of the Ganga river.

SARDHANA CHURCH

The Basilica of Our Lady of Graces, the Church of Sardhana is dedicated to the Virgin Mary. The church was founded by Begum Samru – a Muslim woman who married Walter Reinhardt Sombre – a European mercenary soldier. She got converted in the year 1781. The church of Sardhana boasts a resemblance with St. Peter Basilica of Rome. However, the architectural structure is a bit different as it includes a touch of Indian along with its Palladio architectural style.



HARIDWAR

Formerly Mayapuri is a city and municipal corporation in the Haridwar district of Uttarakhand,The city is situated on the right bank of the Ganges river, at the foothills of the Shivalik ranges. Haridwar lies in doab region where people speak Khari boli. Haridwar is regarded as a holy place for Hindus, hosting important religious events and serving as a gateway to several prominent places of worship. Most significant of the events is the Kumbha Mela, which is celebrated every 12 years in Haridwar.
