The following points were discussed during the meeting:

- As per the separate schedule prepared for discussions on each UN SDG, every discussion commenced with an explanation of the THE Sustainable Impact Ratings methodology, requirements, relevant UN SDG indicators, and documentary evidence required, as explained by the Director, IQAC. The progress of work completed so far was reviewed and discussed with the concerned Faculty SDG Coordinators and IQAC members.
- As decided during the first review meeting, the identification of data and document requirements and communication with the respective Faculty/College/Department for collection of the required information were to be completed by mid-August 2026. At the beginning of each discussion, the Director, IQAC, enquired about the work completed and the tasks still pending. It was observed that, for some SDGs, the concerned Faculty SDG Coordinators had not yet prepared the required emails. Accordingly, all concerned Coordinators were advised to complete this task at the earliest during August 2026. It was also informed that a sample email had already been shared with all SDG Coordinators and IQAC members for reference.



3. All SDG Coordinators and IQAC members were advised to review the practices, reports, documentation, and publicly available information of national and international universities ranked by THE in their respective SDGs. This exercise would help them understand the expected documentation process, the type of evidence required, and the information that should be included or avoided while preparing the SDG reports and uploading data on the THE portal.
4. The Director, IQAC, informed all concerned that, before sending any email for data collection, the SDG Coordinator and concerned IQAC member must first verify whether the required information or documentation is already available with IQAC. Similarly, before proposing or drafting any new policy, the existing policies of the University must be reviewed to determine whether they can be used directly or suitably updated. Relevant provisions may be incorporated or amended in existing policies wherever appropriate to fulfil THE requirements and avoid duplication and unnecessary preparation of new policies.
5. It was discussed that proper indexing of all documents and evidence must be prepared. Supporting documents should be arranged systematically and linked to the respective requirements/indicators so that each piece of evidence can be easily identified, retrieved, cross-verified, and presented during the compilation and submission process.
6. During the discussion on SDG 1, the concerned SDG Coordinator was advised to maintain regularity in carrying out the assigned SDG-related work and ensure that all assigned activities and tasks are completed within the stipulated timelines to avoid delays in the final compilation and submission.
7. The discussion on SDG 2 could not be conducted due to the absence of the respective SDG Coordinator and the concerned IQAC staff member.
8. During the discussion on SDG 3, the concerned team was advised to verify and confirm whether the University has a Smoke-Free Policy in place. If available, the relevant policy and supporting documentary evidence should be collected, properly indexed, and included in the SDG 3 documentation.
9. During the discussion on SDG 4, the Director, IQAC, advised the SDG Coordinator and concerned IQAC member to work in coordination and, before sending emails to the Colleges/Faculties, first identify, consolidate, and clearly specify all required data and documents. This would ensure systematic, complete, and non-duplicative data collection from the concerned units.
10. During the discussion on SDG 5, the concerned IQAC staff member was strictly advised to thoroughly study the THE Sustainable Impact Ratings 2027 manual and requirements to develop a complete understanding of the assigned SDG and its indicators, as it was observed that the requirements were not yet fully understood. Due to the absence of Dr. Sarika, SDG Coordinator for SDG 5, a detailed discussion and comprehensive review of SDG 5 could not be conducted.



11. During the discussion on SDG 9, Dr. Aruna Bansal (IIC), Dr. Nikhil Rathi, Er. K.K. Sharma (USC), and Er. Ritu Sharma (EDC) also attended the meeting. It was noted that activities related to innovation, start-ups, entrepreneurship, research, industry collaboration, and other relevant initiatives must be identified, documented, and appropriately incorporated into the SDG 9 report. The SDG 9 Coordinator explained the relevant requirements and requested the representatives of IIC, USC, and EDC to provide the necessary data and documentary evidence for compilation of the SDG 9 report. It was mutually decided that all concerned members would provide the requested information and documents within one week.
12. The Faculty Coordinator of SDG 10 was advised to report to the IQAC regularly and maintain consistent progress so that the work related to SDG 10 could be expedited and completed within the prescribed timeline.
13. During the discussion on SDG 16, it was observed that the related work needs to be expedited. The concerned team was advised to speed up the preparation and issuance of emails to the respective Faculty/College/Department for timely collection of the required data and documentary evidence.
14. It was resolved that all Faculty SDG Coordinators and the concerned IQAC members shall work in close coordination to compile, verify, index, and systematically organize the required data, documentary evidence, policies, reports, and other supporting documents for their respective SDGs, strictly in accordance with the THE Sustainable Impact Ratings 2027 methodology, indicators, requirements, and guidelines discussed during the meeting. All concerned were further advised to maintain regular progress and adhere to the stipulated timelines to ensure timely and complete compilation of the University's submission.
