

<b>Agenda: 1</b>	<b>Selection of Single Points of Communication (SPOCs) from some departments of the University.</b>
<b>Discussion and Resolutions</b>	<p>Under this agenda, it was resolved to appoint designated Single Points of Communication (SPOCs) from various key departments within the university. An official correspondence will be dispatched, enumerating the appointed individuals from the following departments:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Examination Cell</li> <li>2. IT Department</li> <li>3. Finance Department</li> <li>4. Alumni Cell</li> </ol> <p>The objective behind this initiative is to streamline communication channels and ensure efficient coordination. These appointed SPOCs will serve as the primary liaisons for pertinent matters concerning their respective departments.</p> <p>Furthermore, in alignment with our strategic objectives, the Global Consultancy Services will collaborate closely with the designated SPOCs. Their collective efforts will be directed towards enhancing our university's standing in prestigious</p>

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	international rankings such as the QS Asia Ranking and THE (Times Higher Education) Impact.
<b>Agenda: 2</b>	<b>To secure fifty votes in both the QS Academic Reputation Survey and the QS Employer Reputation Survey.</b>
<b>Discussion and Resolutions</b>	<p>Under this agenda, Mr. Santhosh Karnananda outlined a strategic approach during the discussion. He emphasized the necessity of identifying 50 academicians and 50 employers from well-known corporate sectors who are willing to endorse the university.</p> <p>Subsequently, the Hon'ble Vice Chancellor nominated Mr. Amit Verma, Director of Training and Placement, to take the lead in compiling a comprehensive database of potential employers. This database will facilitate the acquisition of 50 votes in the QS Employer Reputation Survey.</p> <p>The Honorable Vice Chancellor desired that each college provide the particulars of at least 10 distinguished academicians, both nationally and internationally recognized, who may be requested to vote for the university in the QS Academic Reputation Survey.</p> <p>This proactive step underscores our commitment to enhance the university's standing in these crucial surveys, thereby solidifying our reputation among both academia and industry.</p> <p style="text-align: right;"><b>Action by: All Deans, Principals, and HoIs of all Faculty and College and Director T&amp;P Cell</b></p>
<b>Agenda: 3</b>	<b>Initiating Online Training Sessions for Subharti IT Team: Enhancing Perception Across Digital Platforms.</b>
<b>Discussion and Resolutions</b>	<p>During the discussion, Mr. Karnananda emphasized a pivotal agenda item centered on enhancing the university's perception across all digital platforms. It was communicated that Mr. Shyam from Global Consulting Services will conduct bi-monthly training sessions for the IT department. These sessions aim to equip our IT team with the requisite skills and strategies to elevate the university's digital presence.</p> <p>Furthermore, the Honorable Vice Chancellor directed the Chief Technical Officer (CTO) to personally oversee and nominate a representative from the department to participate in these sessions.</p> <p style="text-align: right;"><b>Action by: Mr. Vivek Tiwari (CTO), and GCS – Team (Global Consulting Services Team)</b></p>

  
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<b>Agenda: 4</b>	<b>Facilitating a Meeting Between VFS Global and the University's Controller of Examinations (Scheduled by Global Consulting Services (GCS) Post 3rd March).</b>
<b>Discussion and Resolution</b>	<p>As per the agenda, and with the consent of the University's Controller of Examinations, it has been resolved to arrange an online meeting between VFS Global and the COE. This meeting will be coordinated by Global Consulting Services and is slated to take place on any convenient day after 3rd March 2024. The primary objective of this meeting is to discuss the verification process for student certificates.</p> <p style="text-align: right;"><b>Action by: Controller of Examination, SVSU and Global Consulting Services (GCS)</b></p>
<b>Agenda: 5</b>	<b>To Compile Lists of 500 Alumni in Corporates and Universities Worldwide: Enhancing University Perception.</b>
<b>Discussions and Resolutions</b>	<p>During the discussion led by Mr. Karnananda, it was emphasized that half of our efforts are dedicated to enhancing the university's perception. As a strategic step, it was decided to prepare two comprehensive lists: one comprising 500 alumni working in various corporate sectors worldwide, and the other consisting of 500 alumni engaged in different universities globally.</p> <p>The Hon'ble Vice Chancellor nominated Dr. Sumit Goel, President of the Alumni Trust of the University, who will spearhead the compilation of these lists. Additionally, Dr. Goel will organize engagement activities to foster stronger connections with the enlisted alumni, thereby enhancing their involvement with the university.</p> <p>Recognizing the importance of communication, the Hon'ble Vice Chancellor proposed sharing information about university activities throughout the year with alumni via email. It was also agreed that newsletters and other updates would be regularly disseminated by the Alumni Trust to keep alumni informed and engaged.</p> <p>These initiatives aim not only to strengthen alumni ties but also to elevate the university's reputation and perception worldwide.</p> <p style="text-align: right;"><b>Action by: Dr. Sumit Goel Professor, Subharti Dental College, Annual Alumni Trust President</b></p>

  
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<b>Agenda: 6</b>	<b>To organize a Training Session on THE (Times Higher Education) Impact Rankings by Global Consulting Services.</b>
<b>Discussion and Resolutions</b>	<p>A decision has been reached to conduct a comprehensive training session to equip our university team for participation in the prestigious THE Impact Rankings. This training initiative will be facilitated by Global Consulting Services, and aimed at preparing our staff members effectively.</p> <p>The training session will involve active participation from key stakeholders including Deans, Directors, the Registrar, Heads of Institutions, and Department Heads.
