Reason for Appeal:

While reviewing the grade awarded for this metric HEI regret to mention that due to oversight an error occurred at the time of filling the data in SSR within the prescribed format.

The question asked in sub metric 5.2.1.2 was total no. of students appeared in competitive examinations (249) out of which 228 have cleared. Whereas, HEI had given the data of total no. of students graduated (6658) during the last 5 years which brought the percentage down to 3.4.3%.

During the DVV clarification the query regarding the total number of students cleared the competitive examination in A.Y. 2019-2020 (only) was raised for which data was submitted along with the supporting documents. \land

Registrar Swami Vivokanand Subharti University MEERUT No clarification was raised on the total no. of students appeared in competitive examination hence HEI was not able to submit the data for the same.

Instead DVV considered the number of students graduated as number of students appeared as was enormously submitted by HEI.

HEI therefore request that for sub metric 5.2.1.2, the data may please be amended as 249 (Total no. of students appeared) instead of 6658 (total no. of students graduated) and accordingly the response to this metric would be revised to $(228 \times 100)/249=91.5\%$

HEI earnestly request to consider the above mentioned corrected data for upgrading the metric 5.2.1.
