Shaheed Baba Deep Singh, Department of Home Science of SVSU, Meerut held a **value added course on** maternal and newborn health quality of care from 2.04.2018 to 5.05.2018. The course was attended by 47 participants from different stream. The course aimed to strengthen maternal health and quality of health care through updating students on the recent framework, standards and guidelines to adopt and implement an integrated minimum basic package of interventions aimed at delivering a better quality of maternal and newborn health, before, during and after childbirth.

The specific objectives of this Value Added Course were:

- To train students about the maternal and newborn health.
- To train students on childbirth clinical guidelines, standards of care, effective interventions, and measures
 of quality of maternal and newborn health care; and
- To develop the skills of students in utilizing quality of care self-assessment tools in order to improve the quality of service delivery.

The course was conducted by Dr. Nishma Singh, Assistant Professor Department of Home Science. She highlighted the crucial role of quality of care in improving maternal and newborn health along the continuum of care and the need to address the quality of maternal and newborn health services in line. She noted that special attention should be given to areas with a high burden of maternal and child mortality and rural areas in crisis situations. She also stressed the critical role of child and maternal health during the childbirth period for saving the maximum number of maternal and newborn lives and preventing stillbirths.

Participants identified the main challenges to improving maternal and newborn health-

- · lack of supportive regulations;
- · poor health facility services and referral systems;
- · shortage of maternal and newborn care providers and lack of capacity;
- lack of maternal and newborn health policies and strategies, and absence of interaction/collaboration between management departments of maternal and newborn health and quality improvement;

- prioritization of universal health coverage with non-inclusion of the quality-of-care improvement component;
- existence of some cultural barriers, leading to the low status of women in local communities.
- · building face-to-face communication and knowledge-sharing;
- social media sharing information produced through hospital websites;

- Strategies to improve maternal and child Heath in India.
