





Chhatrapati Shivaji Subharti Hospital has 27 spacious wards 13 major and 7 minor operation theatres, a well equipped Nursery Ward for premature babies. 8 intensive care unit for critically ill patient Surgical, Burn, Medicine, Obstetrics & Gynaecological, Cardiac, Pulmonary Medicine, Pediatrics and Neonatalogy), and a 30 bedded Accident & Trauma Unit. <u>Subharti Channel</u>: Subharti Channel is our sister concern where our students get practical exposure in channel.







A special feature of Department is the adoption of updated curriculum with an emphasis on Information Technology and training of library automation software packages.



Academic

ACADEMIC COUNCIL

The Academic Council is the principal academic body of the University and is subject to the provisions of Statutes and Ordinances. It co-ordinates and exercises general supervision over the academic policies of the University. Academic Council recommends degrees, diplomas, certificates, medals and other awards and distinction which may be awarded by the University. It controls and regulates the maintenance of the standard of instructions, education and research carried on or imparted in the University. It finalises all academic matters including matters relating to examination conducted by the University. It also considers recognition of degrees and diplomas of other Universities and institutions and their equivalence with the degrees and diplomas of the University. The composition is at **annexure-1**.

FACULTY BOARD

All decisions taken by the Board of Studies are considered by the Faculty Board and thereafter forwarded to Academic Council. The Faculty Board recommends the panel of examiners to the Vice-Chancellor, considers research proposals of various Departments, supervises activities of academic, research etc. Its composition is at annexure-II.

BOARD OF STUDIES

Board of Studies are constituted for Department of the Faculty by the Dean concerned.

The Board of Studies prepares, examines the syllabus keeping in view of the objective, interest of the stake holders, national requirements and finalise its recommendation for consideration and approval of the Academic Council. Its composition is at **annexure-III**.

EXAMINATION COMMITTEE

The Examination Committee supervises all the examinations of the University including moderation and tabulation to ensure their proper conduct and to review from time to time the results of the University. The Examination Committee takes appropriate action whenever necessary against candidates, paper setters, examiners, moderators or any other person connected with the conduct of an examination, if found guilty of malpractices in in this context. The composition is at **annexure-IV**.

UNIVERSITY RESEARCH COMMITTEE

The University has constituted 3 Research Committees, one for the medical group and two for non-medical group to develop and expand innovation in research studies and personnel for addressing important national and global needs.

The broad objectives of the University's Research and Patent Cell (URPC) are to prepare and regularly update the Research Policy and formulate guidelines to carry out the Research and Patents, to check plagiarism in research; to ensure correct use of grant in aid received or given to, for research projects etc.

The constitution of the 3 University Research Committees is at **annexure-V.**

Administrative

COURT

The Court is the highest statutory body of the University and has the following powers:

- a) To review from time to time the broad policies and programmes of the University and suggest measures for improvement of working and development of the University.
- b) To consider and pass Resolutions on the Annual Report and the Annual Accounts of the University and Audit Report of such Accounts.

To nominate Members for various Councils or Government, Semi-Government or Private Bodies, where such a Member is required to be sent and represent the University for specific period. The composition is at **annexure**–VI

EXECUTIVE COUNCIL

The Executive Council is the Principal Executive Body of the University. The Executive Council may create supernumerary post and a post of Professor Emeritus. The Executive Council shall take action with regard to the number and qualifications of teachers. It shall give due consideration to every Resolution of the Court and take appropriate action thereon as it shall deem fit and report to the Court. Any decision taken by Academic Council, Examination Committee and Finance Committee is to be approved by Executive Council. The constitution of Executive Council is at annexure – VII.

FINANCE COMMITTEE

The Finance Committee of the University is the principal financial body of the University which takes care of University financial matters through the Finance Department. The budget and financial estimates of the University prepared by the Finance Committee for the concerned financial year is placed for approval before the Executive Council of the University. It may also fix limits for the total recurring and non recurring expenditure within the approved budget for the financial year. The composition of the committee is at annexure-VIII.

PURCHASE COMMITTEE

University's Purchase committee is prime body to take indents from the departments/committees/ faculties etc against requirement, followed by supervision of all purchases from requirement, assessment to vendor selection for comparison and requisite recommendations. Items to be purchased are based on guidelines related to technical specifications. It maintains transparency, accountability and fairness in the procurement process. Purchase committee is also responsible to frame necessary guidelines for store purchase. Its composition is at annexure-IX.

CONDEMNATION BOARD

The Condemnation Board is responsible to write off the unserviceable stores/ assets/ computers/ furniture's etc. lying/fixed at various places of the University through proper disposal of obsolete and unserviceable items as per Government ruling and University directives. The purpose of Board is to select those items which have become condemnable and need to be disposed off, after taking proper approvals form Finance Committee/ Executive Council as the case may be. Its composition is at **annexure-X**.

MAINTENANCE COMMITTEE

Swami Vivekanand Subharti University is spread in an area of about 250 acres, which constitutes within campus nineteen institutions for higher education, auditoriums, sports fields, central libraries, several residential accommodations for teaching and non-teaching staff blocks, hostels for boys and girl separately, working women hostel and hostels for foreign students, having large infrastructure of buildings for teaching various programmes. In addition each institution has number of Tutorial Rooms, Lecture Halls, Seminar Halls, Laboratories, Libraries and Auditorium etc.

In order to maintain the infrastructure of the institutions, maintain its green campus and gardens, fields to maintain and streamline the upkeep and upgradation of the campus, the maintenance committee plays a vital role. Its composition is at **annexure-XI**.

ETHICAL COMMITTEE

Based on legal requirements and to inculcate right approach to all research, Subharti University has 2 Institutional Ethics Committees. As the name suggests these committees ensure all the extant directives and follows all protocols during the entire process of research. Its composition is at **annexure-XII**:

INTERNAL QUALITY ASSURANCE CELL

The University IQAC channelises and systematizes the efforts and measures of all constituent institutions towards academic excellence. It facilitates and participates to improve all segments of academic excellence of the University. The IQAC is a driving force for ushering in quality by working out intervention strategies to remove deficiencies and enhance quality. Its composition is at **annexure-XIII**:

Welfare

EQUAL OPPORTUNITY CELL

In pursuance with the adoption and implementation of Harmonised Guidelines and accessibility Standards for Barrier Free Environment for Persons with Disability and Elderly Persons, developed by Ministry of Urban Development, Govt. of India, the University has created "Equal Opportunity Cell". Its composition is at annexure-XIV.

INTERNAL COMPLAINT COMMITTEE FOR SEXUAL HARASSMENT

In compliance to the MHRD notification dated 02.05.2016 on University Grants Commission (Prevention, Prohibition and Redressal of Sexual Harassment of Women Employees and students in higher educational institutions) Regulations 2015, the Internal Complaint Committee has been constituted. Its composition is at annexure- XV.

PROCTORIAL BOARD

The Board has been constituted so as to maintain the discipline in and around the campus. The proctorial board and its members are always alert and respond in a timely and efficient manner. The composition is at annexure-XVI.

ANTI RAGGING COMMITTEE

The Anti Ragging Committee of the University has been constituted in compliance of the provisions of Anti Ragging Ordinance No.VII(6) and to monitor the activities of Anti Ragging Squad for prevention of ragging in the University. Its composition is at annexure-XVII.

DISCIPLINARY COMMITTEE

Disciplinary committee is the recommendatory unit of the University to help university administration in taking a holistic approach and decision for dealing with problems arising out of misconduct of students; conflicts/fights amongst individuals or groups; violation of rules with regard to ragging, smoking, drinking, indulging in drugs, teasing, trespassing, thefts, misappropriation etc. Misrepresentation of any kind is treated as a serious disciplinary issue to be dealt with. Its composition is at **annexure-XVIII.**

GRIEVANCE REDRESSAL & WELFARE CELL

University has an active Grievance Redressal & Welfare Cell which is very sensitive to all grievance and their redressal. Besides phone numbrs of Centralized Cell, the numbers of Grievance Redressal & Welfare Cells have been displayed at various locations of the University including in each college. Its composition is at annexure-XIX.

SPORTS COMMITTEE

To promote sports amongst students, the University provides finances for sports activities. A sports committee is constituted for this purpose. Its composition is at **annexure-XX**.

CULTURAL COMMITTEE

To promote cultural activities amongst students, the Cultural Committee organizes inter college, inter university, state level programmes and helps in organizing cultural programmes. To promote cultural activities and to encourage students, the University provides finances. The students are also provided daily allowances for outstation activities and financial support towards travel and equipments by the University. Its composition is at **annexure-XXI**.




