Dr. N.K. Ahuja Hon'ble Vice Chancellor, SVSU, Meerut, addressed the participants and discussed the importance of stakeholders' feedback while updating and designing the curriculum of any academic programme. He added that every Faculty/College should adopt this continuous process of taking feedback from all stakeholders and discuss the suggestions with all the faculty members for improvement for designing the curriculum.

He further explained, curriculum is the foundation of the teaching-learning process. The development of programs of study, learning and teaching resources, lesson plans and assessment of students, and even teacher education are all based on curriculum.

The curriculum developers should adapt a participatory approach and involve teachers in decision making for their areas of specialty in order to improve its acceptability and effective implementation.

He briefed that the University follows a continuous review system of the curriculum in which feedback from stakeholders – management, faculty members, students, parents, employers, professionals and alumni are taken into account. In this orientation programme, 88 faculty members have shown their active involvement and shared their experiences based on the methodology which they are following in their respected colleges for curriculum improvement.
