

Workshop on “Bloom’s Taxonomy: Basis for Teaching and Learning”

A three days workshop on “Bloom's Taxonomy: Basis for Teaching and Learning” was organized by Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) in collaboration with Faculty of Education, Swami Vivekanand Subharti University (SVSU), Meerut during 26th-28th September 2019. In this workshop distinguished resource persons Dr. Navneet Sharma, Assistant Professor, Central University of Himachal Pradesh, Dr. Anoj Kumar, Head, Department of Education, Dr. Santosh Sharma, Professor, Professor, Department of Education, SVSU, Meerut delivered sessions on different aspects and practices of Teaching and Learning.

First Day: Dated: September 26th, 2019

Dr. Sandeep Singh, Dean-Faculty of Education, SVSU welcomed the invited guest Dr. Navneet Sharma and all the participants of the workshop.
