THREE DAYS WORKSHOP ON "NEW PERFORMA OF AQAR"

ORGANISED BY INTERNAL QUALITY ASSURANCE CELL (IQAC)

Innovation and Reform for enhancing quality of education has become the watchword of the present educational system. That is possibly the reason why National Assessment and Accreditation Council (NAAC) – the apex committee for evaluation, assessment and accreditation of higher educational institutions, from time to time, has set forth certain benchmarks to maintain the quality of higher education. Keeping in mind the changing needs of higher education and to develop and transform the educational set up in Swami Vivekanand Subharti University, Meerut, the Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) organized a 3 days' Workshop with the prime objective of providing necessary information and technical support required for making preparations in line with the "NEW PERFORMA OF ANNUAL QUALITY ASSURANCE REPORT (AQAR)" for preparing AQAR 2019-20.

The workshop was successfully organized during 5th-7th September 2019 in the Vice Chancellor Conference Hall of the University under the patronage of honorable Vice-Chancellor Dr. N.K. Ahuja and was graced by the Pro-Vice Chancellor, Dr. D.C Saxena. First day, after giving an introduction on AQAR, Vice Chancellor explained about the New Performa of Annual Quality Assessment Report (AQAR). He enlightened about the difference between the new and the old process of AQAR preparation he spoke about benchmarking, which was not a part of the old system.

After deliberation for hours on previous Assessment and Preparation process of AQAR, the second day technical session started with the coordinator of IQAC, Dr. Neetu Panwar. She emphasized on the current process and the changes introduced in the new AQAR Performa filling process. She explained the process of AQAR Preparation, Data validation and Assessment, Evaluation process as integral to the new system. She explained the technicalities of uploading and preparation of AQAR. While explaining the seven important criteria as basis for assessment, Pro Vice Chancellor had also elaborated on the newly introduced key indicators important for quality assurance and better ranking.

The third day technical session was addressed by Vice Chancellor. After his brief deliberation, he interacted with the participants and discussed various issues of concern related New Performa of Annual Assessment Report (AQAR) for the session 2019-20 to NAAC accreditation.

There was also an interactive/ experience sharing session during which participants raised their queries relating to "New Performa of Annual Assessment Report (AQAR)" process. Discussion made by Dr. Neetu Panwar and other members of the University with the NAAC coordinators and internal IQAC Coordinators of the colleges was also found to be immensely beneficial for the participants.
