**Ordinance No.....A GOVERNING
FOUR YEARS BACHELOR OF MEDICAL LABORATORY SCIENCE (BMLS)
PROGRAMME**

(FOUR YEARS)

(Effective from: 2026-27)


1. This Ordinance may be called the “**Ordinance relating to Bachelor of Medical Laboratory Science (BMLS)**” programme. This ordinance has been drafted in accordance with **National Commission for Allied and Healthcare Professions (NCAHP)** guidelines; all future updates issued by the NCAHP will be strictly implemented.
2. This ordinance shall be applicable from the Academic Session 2026-27.
3. Bachelor of Medical Laboratory Science (BMLS) shall be conducted in the Department of Medical Laboratory Science under the Subharti College of Allied and Healthcare, Faculty of Allied Health Sciences.

I. GENERAL PROVISION

1. The programme of study leading to BMLS of SVSU shall be of four years duration including one-year compulsory internship.
4. The programme of study leading to BMLS of the SVSU shall be conducted in the Department of Medical Laboratory Science under the Subharti College of Allied and Healthcare, Faculty of Allied Health Sciences.
2. The admission to BMLS programme shall be dealt with by the Director Admission Cell and Principal, the last date for the receipt of the application form shall be fixed by the Director, Admission Cell as per the guidelines received from the Uttar Pradesh State Allied and Healthcare Council (UPSAHC).
3. The candidate seeking admission will have to apply on a prescribed format available from the University on payment of prescribed fee.

A. Admission Eligibility Criteria

- a. Candidate must have passed Senior Secondary (10+2) or equivalent with Physics, Chemistry, Biology (Botany + Zoology) subjects.
- b. Admission on the basis of Senior Secondary (10+2) merit.
- c. Candidates who have studied abroad and have possess equivalent qualification as determined by the Association of Indian Universities and Equivalence Committee of the NCAHP and fulfil the above criteria shall also be eligible for admission.
- d. Candidates must be 17 years as on December 31 of the year of admission to first year of Bachelor of Optometry course.

- e. Candidates must furnish a certificate of Physical fitness from an Authorized Medical Professional, at the time of application, to ascertain that the candidate does not have any physical disability.

Provision of Lateral Entry

Lateral entry to the candidates in second year (3rd semester) who have passed Diploma in Medical Laboratory Technology (D. MLT) with 50% marks.

B. Intake: The intake to BMLS programme shall be 40.

C. Degree Awarded: Bachelor of Medical Laboratory Science (BMLS)

II. CONDUCT OF THE PROGRAMME

1. A candidate admitted to the BMLS programme shall be permitted to appear at University examinations only when he/she has been enrolled as a student of the SVSU and has submitted the migration certificate and paid the enrollment fee prescribed herein after by the ordinances.
2. To qualify for the BMLS programme, the candidate must earn the prescribed number of credits as contained in the course structure/syllabus detailed herein after.
3. A student of the BMLS programme shall not be permitted to seek admission concurrently to any other equivalent or higher degree or diploma examination in the university.
4. **Programme Completion Timeline**
All academic coursework must be completed within **8 years** from the date of admission.
Note: Failure to complete the programme within the stipulated maximum duration will result in **automatic exit** from the programme.
5. Inter-University Ordinances i) Notwithstanding anything contained in these ordinances a student who is qualified under the foregoing ordinances for admission to the university, and who is a member of some other Indian University, shall not be admitted to the university or any constituent college/faculty thereof without the production of: a) A leaving or transfer certificate signed by the Principal of the last college attended and certifying to the satisfactory conduct of the student mentioning the highest examination he/she has passed, and b) A certified copy of all the entries against his/her name in the Enrollment Register of the University if such a copy is obtainable.
6. A student of some other Indian University shall in any case be admitted only at the beginning of the particular course which he/she proposes to take in the University.

III. ATTENDANCE RULES

A candidate has to secure minimum-

1. 80% attendance in theoretical.
2. 80% in skill training (practical) for qualifying to appear for the final examination.
No relaxation, whatsoever, will be permissible to this rule under any ground including indisposition etc.

Duration of the programme

Duration of the programme is 4 years or 8 semesters.

Medium of instruction

English shall be the medium of instruction for all the subject of study and for examination of the course.

IV. COURSE STRUCTURE AND SCHEME OF EXAMINATION OF BMLS PROGRAMME

Candidates for the four years BMLS examination shall be examined in the following subjects in accordance with the syllabi or course prescribed in the following ordinances.

1. Course Structure:

The BMLS programme shall be of four years duration. A student is required to offer compulsory courses of **160 credits** in four years as per the details given below. The various courses to be offered in these four years are given below.

Promotion Criteria to higher semesters:

The eligibility for promotion to the next academic year is subject to securing the minimum academic performance as specified below

First to second year: a minimum of 70% of the credits at the end of the first year (includes first and second semester)

Second to third year: a cumulative minimum of 80% of the credits at the end of the second year (includes first, second, third and fourth semester)

Third year to Internship/group project: Students will be eligible for internship (Lab posting/ research dissertation) only after successful completion of the entire coursework, i.e. 100% credits to be accrued by the end of the third year.

The student must complete all the coursework requirements within a maximum of double the programme duration. For example, in a 4-year programme, all the academic coursework needs to be completed within 8 years. Failure to do so will result in exit from the programme.

Progression Criteria to Higher Semesters

Eligibility for promotion to the next academic year is based on the following minimum academic performance requirements:

First Year to Second Year:

A student must secure a minimum of **70% of the total credits** at the end of the first year (i.e., completion of both the first and second semesters).

Second Year to Third Year:

A student must secure a **cumulative minimum of 80% of the total credits** at the end of the second year (i.e., completion of the first to fourth semesters).

Third Year to Internship/Group Project:

A student will be eligible to commence the **Internship (Lab posting/ Research Dissertation)** only after the **successful completion of all coursework**, i.e., **100% of the credits** must be earned by the end of the third year.

7th and 8th Semester: Internship (Lab posting/ Research dissertation):

A compulsory internship (Lab posting/ Research dissertation) of one year - equivalent to 12 months, 52 weeks, or 1800 hours - carrying 40 credits, must be completed by each student to be eligible for the award of the **Bachelor of Medical Laboratory Science (BMLS)**.

If a student opts for Research dissertation, it must be of a minimum duration of 6 months.

During the internship period, students are required to adhere to the rules and regulations of the host organisation.

Upon successful completion, students will receive an Internship Certificate that includes:


A summary of activities undertaken

Details of clinical or relevant departmental postings with corresponding hours


Information on any research project completed during research dissertation

The certificate must be authenticated by the **Dean/ Head of Department (HoD)/Coordinator and the Head of the Institution (HoI)**.


Note: The Bachelor's Degree will be awarded only upon successful completion of the Internship requirements.


