INTERNATIONAL STUDENT ADMISSION POLICY

1. Introduction

These rules define the procedure for the admission of International students to various courses provided by “**Swami Vivekanand Subharti University**” based on General Guidelines issued by the University Grants Commission (UGC), Association of Indian Universities (AIU) and Statutory / Regulatory directives issued from time to time by the Government.

2. Scope

The International Students shall be taken care under the foreign student cell hitherto called “**International Students & Global Relations Cell**” or “**ISGR Cell**”. It will provide necessary guidance for admission by arranging Campaigns/Road Shows/Participation in International Exhibitions/Fairs or by other means, as approved by the Hon’ble Vice Chancellor from time to time. It will be responsible for mobilizing admissions from designated countries approved by Executive Committee of the University. All correspondence related to international students shall emanate from ISGR Cell including promotional support, with foreign recruitment agencies, prospective students and other foreign entities for this purpose.

3. International Students

Foreign students: Students holding passports issued by foreign countries including people of Indian origin, who have acquired the nationality of foreign countries including *subjects of Bhutan & Nepal*.

4. Documents required for admission of International Students

Visa: All the international students will require a student visa endorsed to this Institution for joining full time courses. No other endorsement is acceptable. Students wishing to join a research program will require a research visa endorsed to this Institution. The visa should be valid for the prescribed duration of the course. *Visa is not required for students of Bhutan & Nepal.*

5. Eligibility Qualifications

The qualification/degree provided by International applicant should be in equivalence to the degree awarded at that level by the Indian Universities. Only applicant having qualification recognized as equivalent by the Association of Indian Universities (AIU) are eligible for admission in a particular course of study as per University & related Statutory Body norms applicable from time to



time. When required a reference will be made to AIU to check the equivalence. However, in certain cases if AIU does not give the equivalence and the applicant is eligible as per their country norms then the decision by the Hon'ble Vice Chancellor will be final.

A candidate should have completed 17 years of age on or before 31st December of the year of admission. There will be no bar on upper age unless specified by any of the Statutory Body i.e. UGC, MCI, DCI, INC, AICTE, etc or the Swami Vivekanand Subharti University for admission in a particular course of higher education.

Under this category, only the students who have studied and passed the qualifying examination from a school located in foreign country shall be considered.

The candidate shall have to obtain equivalence certificate from the Association of Indian University (AIU), New Delhi.

6. Equivalence Certificate:

- a. For issue of Equivalence Certificate, **US \$ 200** (or as applicable from time to time) or equivalent Indian currency payable through Demand Draft favoring “**Association of Indian Universities, New Delhi**” is to be paid by the student in addition to other fees & charges.
- b. For this purpose prescribed application form is to be submitted by the student/university to the “Association of Indian Universities, New Delhi” as per **Annexure I**. Detailed guidelines of Association of Indian Universities, New Delhi for International students are available on www.aiuweb.org/evaluation/evaluation.asp

7. Admission Procedure & General Rules:

- a. Admission of all the international students will be done through the **International Students & Global Relations Cell**.
- b. A student wishing to join the University should submit application form (**Annexure II**) to the **International Student & Global Relations Cell** along with the prescribed fee. The student will also submit all the required documents by mail or by post.
- c. The documents will be sent to the Association of Indian Universities by the student himself or by the University along with the prescribed fee, for getting the equivalence certificate to certify that the student fulfills the



criteria for admission in the particular course.

- d. After verifying the eligibility of the candidate for admission in a particular course the ISGR Cell will issue a provisional admission letter to the student and will ask the student to obtain Visa from the appropriate authority.
- e. After submitting copy of Visa and/or any other certificate required from the Embassy/Government for admission, the student will be informed to deposit the required fee and the Medical Certificate issued by the competent authority of his/her country or country from he/she is coming.
- f. The student will also undergo medical examination after reporting to the University. If a student is found to be harboring any communicable disease, the student may be deported back to his native country.
- g. The international students will pay the fees in US dollars except students from Nepal, Bhutan and other selected SAARC countries (as may be decided from time to time), who will pay the fee in INR. In special cases, payment of fee in the equivalent Indian Rupees may be considered based on then prevailing US\$ conversion index. The details of fee are mentioned in **Annexure-III**.
- h. The full course fee will be deposited at the time of admission unless permitted by the competent authority of the University to pay the fee in installments or on yearly basis subject to any condition like deposition of Bank Guarantee or any other equivalent guarantee/assurance by the Embassy of the Country of origin of the student which may be imposed by the competent authority. The fees are liable to revision anytime and students will have to pay the revised fees as and when applicable.
- i. Living in the Campus in Hostel is mandatory unless otherwise permitted by the competent authority.
- j. After the student reports for admission, the ISGR Cell will send the information to F.R.R.O. Meerut. The student will also report to FRRO in Meerut in person. Report will be sent to FRRO on each occasion the student leaves the Hostel / University.
- k. The student will be given a detailed orientation by ISGR Cell about the culture and law of the land and the regulations of regulating bodies.
- l. Though, the medium of study is English but the student will have to learn workable knowledge of Hindi because it is in his/her interest. Classes will



be arranged by the University.

- m. The ISGR Cell will also report to the State Government / the Central Government /the Embassy wherever required as per law and if felt necessary by the University.
- n. The ISGR Cell will continue to play the role as a coordinating agency between the foreign students and F.R.R.O. for periodic reporting.
- o. The foreign students will not be required to appear in the entrance examination held for the particular course by the University unless it is under the rules of the statutory body. However, they should fulfill the qualifying criteria as laid down by the University.
- p. Only the permitted number of foreign students will be admitted in a particular course as per the regulations laid down by the Central Government / Statutory Bodies / Swami Vivekanand Subharti University or the Hon'ble Court.
- q. Following the admission of a foreign students in any of the colleges of the University, it shall be the prime responsibility of the Principal/Director/Dean of the institute/college/faculty concerned and the hostel warden to supervise and manage all affairs of the student including disciplinary matters, performance review and payment of their dues to the university etc. as applicable to other students.
- r. In case of absenteeism of the student from the College/Hostel:
 - (i) If the student is absent both from the college and the hostel without any written information even for one day, the matter will be reported to the FRRO and the local police.
 - (ii) If the student is absent for seven days or more from the college and the hostel, the matter will be reported to the FRRO, the local police and the concerned Embassy.
- s. Any charges towards remittance of fee are to be borne by the student.
- t. Registration Fee: US\$ 250 subject to change from time to time.
- u. No re-registration / registration fee is required for already existing student / alumni for higher or new courses in the same campus.
- v. Registration amount or any other fee once deposited is not refundable in any case.



- w. Issuance of provisional offer letter (conditional or unconditional) or any information or guidance or facilitation given by the university should not be construed as confirmation of admission or access to any facility of university unless so specifically informed.
- x. Total course fee applicable in US\$ as approved by the university.

8. Change of Course and/or the Institution/University:

- a. An international student who has been granted admission to a particular course shall not be allowed to change the course in between.
- b. **Transfer from Swami Vivekanand Subharti University to another Institution / University is not allowed. The student will be free to get his admission cancelled and can take admission in another Institution / University with the permission of the relevant authorities.**
- c. No credit transfer is allowed in any case.

9. Discipline:

The international students will abide by all the rules of the Institution and the code of conduct as applicable to Indian students doing same course.

10. Examination and Award of Degrees & Diplomas:

The procedure for examination, issue of marks sheet, issue of passing certificate and award of degrees will be same as for the Indian students pursuing the same course.

11. Exit Policy:

If a foreign student leaves the University without informing the university, the following actions shall be taken:

- The matter will be reported to his/her Parents, FRRO, the Home & Foreign Ministry of Central Government or any other authority designated by the Central Government for the purpose, the local police, the concerned Embassy [as per clause 7\(r\)](#).
- If the student does not report to the University within one month and University receives no information about his/her whereabouts, the University will send a warning letter to the student for the cancellation of admission. If the student does not respond within the specified time then the Vice Chancellor has the authority to cancel the admission of the student and will send the information to the Student, Parents, FRRO and



the concerned Embassy.

12. Act of Indiscipline or non-performance:

~~i. In case of minor case of indiscipline the same rule shall apply as are applied to Indian students for conducting enquiry and giving punishment. However, before taking any action the counseling of the student will be done as a first step.~~

~~ii. In case of major case of indiscipline which may amount to danger to the peace in the vicinity or danger to the security of the Country, the matter may be reported to FRRO, the home and Foreign Ministry of Central Government or any other authority designated by the Central Government for the purpose, the local police, the concerned embassy and the student may be deported to the parent country and after cancellation of the admission by the University. In such a case, no fee shall be refunded.~~

Note :

- a. Expulsion of any student from the college can be done only by the Hon'ble Vice Chancellor on the recommendation of the Hostel Warden/Principal.
- b. Fee once deposited shall not be refunded in any case of expulsion and the fine incurred shall be payable extra.

13. Non-performance by the student or repeated failures:

- The Principal/Director/Dean of the institute/college/faculty will appoint any senior student or any faculty member as the mentor of the student who will try to find out the problems and the reasons for non-performance by the student and will try to sort them out.
- In case the matter is not solved at the level of the institute/college/faculty, the Principal/Director/Dean will inform the ISGR Cell. The Director of the Cell will depute any officer of the cell to look into the problems of the student and will try to solve them.

14. Non payments of dues.



- In case of nonpayment of charges or fee of the University under any head, it shall be the duty of the Principal/Director/Dean of the Institute/College/Faculty concerned and/or the Hostel Warden to take appropriate action. The Principal/Director/Dean of the Institute/College/Faculty concerned and / or the Hostel Warden shall send a copy of the dues to the ISGR Cell, who shall inform the Embassy, recruiting agency, parent of the student. A reminder of the dues shall be sent at least two months in advance from the commencement of the examination or immediately after the last date of the fee deposition whichever is earlier and in the case of non-clearance of the dues the student shall be debarred from the examination, unless otherwise permitted by the Hon'ble Vice Chancellor.

15. Scholarship Scheme for Foreign Students (for the session 2017-18 and 2018-19)

- (a) Zambia An eligible student will get scholarship on total course fee if total grades of any five subjects (Including Qualifying subject, if any) is up to 16 as per following slabs:

- (i) An eligible student having WAEC certificate will get scholarship on total course fee on the basis of the percentage of any five subjects (Including Qualifying subject, if any) as per following slabs:

- (e) **Middle East :** (United Arab Emirates, Saudi Arabia, Armenia, Qatar, Baharain, Kuwait, Oman, Yemen, Iran, Iraq, Israel, Jordan, Lebanon, Palestinian territories, Syria and Turkey) Flat 25% scholarship on total course fee for UG and PG courses. (Fee Structure applicable = Foreign fee structure (USD) + Registration Charges of USD 250)
- (f) **SAARC Countries** (Nepal, Bangladesh, Afghanistan, Sri Lanka, Pakistan, Maldives (Except Bhutan)): Flat 35% scholarship on total course fee for UG and PG courses. (Fee Structure applicable = Indian fee structure (INR) + Country Registration Charges)
- (g) A scholarship of 20% of total course fee will be given to the already existing foreign students/ alumni seeking admission for higher studies



(For the session 2019-20).

- (a) **All African Countries:** Flat 25% scholarship on total course fee for UG and PG courses.

(Fee structure applicable = Foreign fee structure (USD) + Registration charges of USD 250).

- (b) **South East Asian Countries:** (Myanmar, Cambodia, Indonesia, Vietnam, Brunei, Laos, Malaysia, Philippines, Singapore, Thailand)

Flat 25% scholarship on total course fee for UG and PG course

(Fee structure applicable = Foreign fee structure (USD) + Registration charges of USD 250)

- (ii) **Bangladesh, Nepal & Sri Lanka:**

Flat 25% scholarship on first year total course fee (excluding refundable security) for UG and PG courses.

(Fee structure applicable = India fee structure (INR) + Country Registration charges)

- (iii) **Bhutan:**

Flat 25% scholarship on first year total course fee (excluding refundable security) only for self-finance students for UG and PG courses.

(Fee structure applicable = India fee structure (INR) + Registration



charges)

- (e) A Scholarship of 25% of the total course fee will be given to the already existing Foreign Students/alumni seeking admission for higher studies.

Note: In special cases the scholarship may be extended up to 50%.
