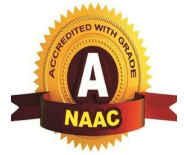

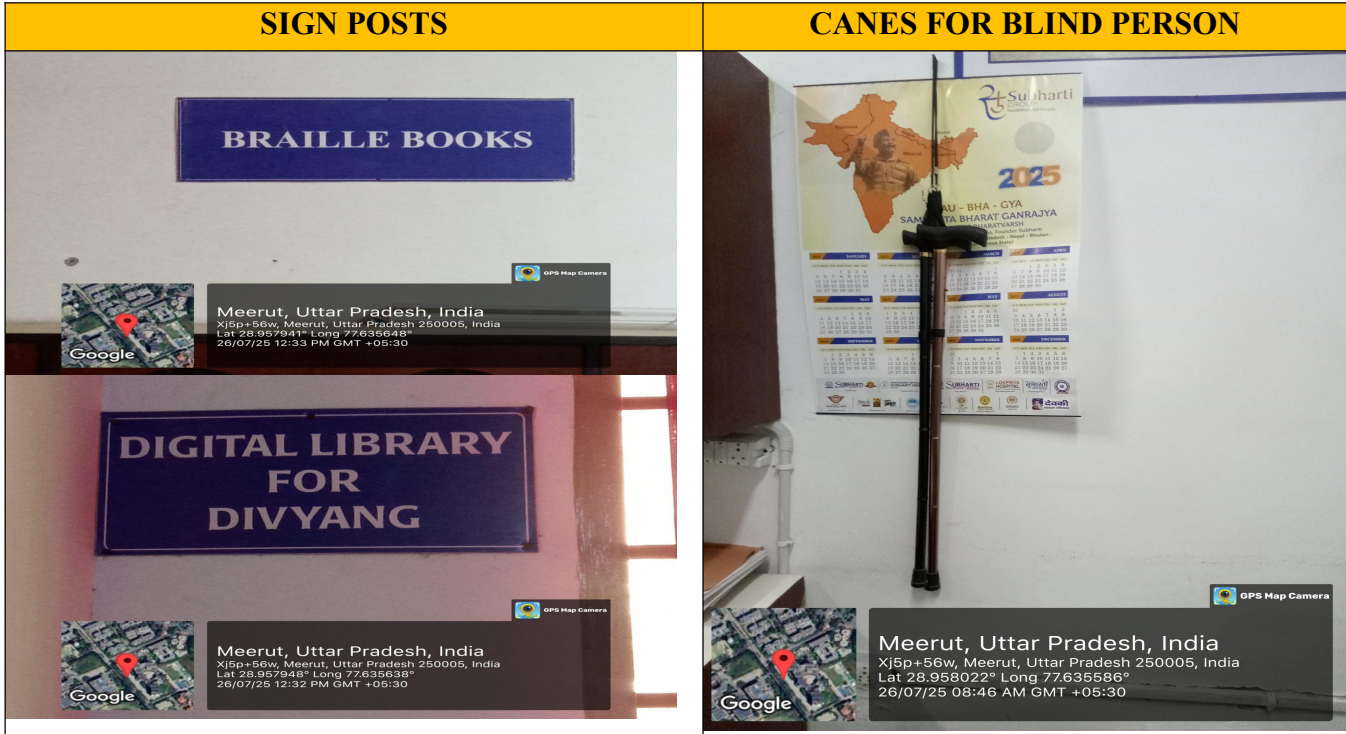

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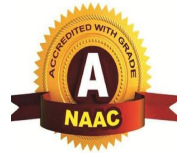

NOTIFICATION

Sub: fee concession / free ship- in respect of Persons with Benchmark Disabilities. -regarding.

This is in continuation to various efforts of the University to cater deprived section of the society and to adopt inclusive approach (as enriched in SDGs), the Swami Vivekanand Subharti University is adopting equal opportunity while catering education of the person with disabilities which is possible only after financial parameters. Therefore, initially University is not making reservation in number of seats but facilitating the targeted population with fee concession/ free ships.

The Competent Authority of University has approved the rules for grant of educational fee concession / free ship to the Persons with Disability (PwD), taking admission in the undergraduate programme of studies in Arts & Social Sciences, Fine Arts, Science, Education, Law, Diploma, Naturopathy, Management, Engineering / M.Tech,-disciplines

The Persons with disabilities shall be given concession / free ship in annual tuition fee prescribed in respective programme of studies (UG) for admission depending on Benchmark disability. This exemption shall be available only to such persons who enclose with the application form, necessary certificate from a competent authority in support of their claim of disability. Only such persons would be eligible for concession who suffer from not less than 40 per cent of relevant disability.

The details of concession given are;

| Benchmark Disabilities | Definition of Category of disability | % of Concession Admissible on Annual Tuition Fee |
|------------------------|---|--|
| Blindness | 1. "Blindness" refers to a condition where a person suffers from any of the following conditions, namely:- 1.1. total absence of sight; or 1.2. visual acuity not exceeding 6/60 or 20/200(snellen) in the better eye with correcting lenses; or 1.3. limitation of the field of vision subtending an angle of 20 degree or worse; | 50% |
| Low vision | "Person with low vision" means a person with impairment of visual functioning even after treatment or standard refractive correction but who uses or is potentially capable of using vision for the planning or execution of a task with appropriate assistive device. | 35% |
| Hearing Impairment | "Hearing Impairment" means loss of sixty decibels or more in the better ear in the conversational range of frequencies. | 40% |

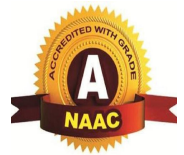

| Locomotor disability | Locomotor disability " means disability of the bones, joints or muscles leading to substantial restriction of the movement of the limbs or any form of cerebral palsy. | 40% |
| orthopedically handicapped | All the cases of orthopedically handicapped persons would be covered under the category of "locomotor disability or cerebral palsy." | 40% |
| PwD -Dwarf | Dwarfism- a medical or genetic condition resulting in an adult height of 4 feet 10 inches (147 centimeters) or less | 40% |

The other benefits extended / facilitated by the University to PwD candidates are:

1. **National Scholarship for Persons with Disabilities:** The National Scholarship for Persons with Disabilities is a government initiative aimed at supporting students with disabilities, including those who are blind. This scholarship helps with tuition fees, books, and other educational expenses for students at the graduation / post-graduation level.
2. **Permission to use an amanuensis:** the PwD candidates will be permitted to use the services an amanuensis in all or any of the papers. A student of class lower than the one for which the candidate will be allowed for taking the examination.
3. Blind, Physically Handicapped or Spastic Candidate will be provided services of an amanuensis free of cost, the other PwD candidate shall pay the fee as prescribed for use of the amanuensis.
4. Additional time of 60 minutes (1 hour) in each paper of examination as per government norms
5. Alternative type questions are provided in lieu of questions having visual inputs for the blind candidates in English Communicative and Social Sciences
6. Blind candidates will have the facility to use computer or a typewriter for writing answers;
7. The candidate will eligible for only one scholarship at a time- and should not be taking any other scholarship from any other government /NGO
