**Objective of the Workshop:**

**QEWC (Quality Enhancement Working Committee) of Subharti Dental college & Hospital organized a Workshop on "Outcome based attainment for Programmes" in collaboration with IQAC, Swami Vivekanand Subharti University.** The main objective of the Workshop was to understand the CO-PO (Course Outcomes and Programme Outcomes) Mapping, Course and Programme attainment based on outcomes and gap assessment calculations for programme outcomes and their attainment.

**Activities:** Guest Speaker, Dr Neetu Panwar, Director, IQAC, Swami Vivekanand Subharti University elaborated on this topic. Chief NAAC Coordinator, Subharti Dental College & Hospital, Dr Vineeta Nikhil along with all Departmental NAAC Coordinators and some Faculty members actively participated in this Hands-on workshop.

The Guest Speaker explained that Programme and course Outcomes for BDS and MDS have been formulated for all specialties following DCI regulations, which helps in enhancing the Curriculum requirements. Thus, an important step to obtain programme based outcomes is the CO-PO mapping. All participants worked on Excel sheet in their laptops and completed the CO-PO mapping of their respective specialties for MDS Programmes. The speaker explained clearly how to make the tabulated data for Post-graduate students results and how to calculate course attainment values for various courses. She further discussed the relevance of Programme attainment values and target values. The guest speaker demonstrated on Excel sheet as well as on White Board how to calculate gap assessment values for Programme outcomes and their attainment. All exit survey forms for

example alumni, employer and professional feedback forms were also discussed and demonstrated by the Speakers.

All attendees simultaneously worked on their respective COs and POs of their Departments, on their Laptops. The delegates were enthusiastic and discussed their queries with the Speaker.





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
