Minutes of Board of Studies

A meeting of Board of Studies of Department of Forensic Medicine was held today on 15.02.2017 at 10:30 AM in the chamber of the undersigned and following members were present.

- 1. Dr. Bhim Singh (Associate Professor) In Chair
- 2. Dr. Abhishek Sangal (Assistant Professor)

Dr. A. K. Srivastava (Professor & Head) and Dr. Mithun Ghosh (Assistant Professor) could not attend the meeting.

At the onset, the Chairperson BoS welcomed all the members and following items were taken up as per agenda.

a) Agenda item No. 1: - To confirm the minutes of previous BoS held on 14/04/2016.

The members confirmed and passed the minutes. (Annexure -1)

b) Agenda item No. 2: - To report action taken on minutes of Board of Studies held on 14/04/2016. (Annexure - 2)

Action taken -

- 1. The feedback of MBBS students was taken regarding the MBBS programme and the students provided a positive response. No changes in the programme/course curriculum or teaching/evaluation methodology were done.
- 2. The list of Panel of examiners were approved and recommended to COE.
- c) Agenda item No.3: To consider and adopt the new curriculum for MBBS programme as prescribed by MCI.

The members approved that no new curriculum for MBBS programme has been introduced by MCI.

d) Agenda item No.4: - To consider running of value-added course in the programme for graduate and post-graduate as per the annexure.

No such course was proposed to be introduced in the MBBS/M.D. programme.

e) <u>Agenda item No.5</u>: - <u>To examine the feedback analysis for the MBBS programme for the year 2017.</u>

Members reported that students were satisfied with the current teaching methodology

- f) Agenda item No.6: To consider and approve the board of examiners for theory and practical examination for the MBBS programme.
 - Approved and recommended to COE.

- g) Agenda item No.7: To consider and approve review of curricula for the following courses in MBBS/M.D. programme.
 - 1. The chairperson quoted Hon. Supreme Court judgement dated 1/6/2007 regarding passing criteria of MBBS students, and proposed that to pass a professional exam, student must obtain minimum 50% marks in theory and minimum 50% marks in practical as well.
 - 2. He also quoted change in M.D. Forensic Medicine examination passing criteria as per Supreme Court guidelines, the student must obtain minimum 50% marks in theory as well as in practical. He opined to propose both the judgements in Faculty Board for approval.
 - **3.** The members were also informed about the compulsory introduction of MCQ in Semester and Professional examinations of MBBS course by MCI.
