

HoD Physiology- Dr. Kiran Singh, Biochemistry-Dr. B.K. Gupta, HoD-Forensic Medicine, Dr. Bhim Singh, and Psychiatry-Dr. Sandeep Chaudhary & Radio-Diagnosis-Dr. B.B. Thukral attended the meeting, online on Zoom.

- 1. Dr. A.K. Srivastava, Principal & Dean, welcomed all the Heads & Medical Superintendent CSSH. The meeting started with confirmation of minutes of previous faculty board meeting dated 22.07.2019 Dr. Srivastava informs the house that Competency Based Medical Curriculum, passed in previous Faculty board meeting, is approved by Hon'ble Vice Chancellor. Now it will be placed in next Academic Council meeting for rectification.
- 2. HoD Paramedical Sciences informed that course B.Sc. Optometry was approved in Academic Council meeting dated 20.07.2018 subject to appro0val by Govt. of U.P. through Uttar Pradesh State Medical Faculty, Lucknow. The portal of State Medical Faculty, U.P. for registration of the course is not open till date and even after registration, the process of inspection and approval requires about two years. So, it is proposed to give permission to start BSc. Optometry for academic session 2019-20. The process of registration will be done as and when portal allows.
- 3. HOD, Paramedical Science also informed that there are 30 seats for admission in three streams of M.Sc. MLT programme. Admission in this course is low usually from 6 to 10 admission per year. So it is proposed that admission in M.Sc. MLT should be decreased to 20 from 30 per academic year.
- 4. HOD, Forensic Medicine, informed that M.D. Forensic Medicine programme was permitted by Medical Council of India, from 2011-12 for one admission per year. The course was recognized by MCI subject not to take admission further till the permission of medico-legal postmortem by State Government to the mortuary of Subharti Medical College, By the Faculty of Forensic Medicine. Inspite of repeated request and reminders UP Govt. has not yet permitted postmortem and it is not expected in near future too. So it is proposed that the MD Forensic Medicine should be discontinued form academic session 2019-20.
- HOD, Pharmacology, informed that M.Sc. in Medical Pharmacology was started in 2008 but no admission occurs till date. So it is proposed that the programme M.Sc. Medical Pharmacology Should be discontinued from academic session 2019-20.

- 6. HODs of Anatomy, Physiology, Pathology, Ophthalmology, Psychiatry, Surgery, Medicine & Paramedical Science informed that the value added courses are started in their department but approval from Academic Council is pending. So it is proposed that "Basics of Histological Techniques" in Anatomy "Body Composition Analysis" in Physiology; "Haemovigilance and Judicious use of Blood and Blood Components" in Pathology; "Learning and Mastering the skill of fundus Examination and Fluorescein angiography" in Ophthalmology; "IQ Assessment in Children, adolescents and adults" in Psychiatry; "Basic of minimal invasive surgery- Laparoscopy" in Surgery; "Hemodialysis-from bed side to dialysis room" & "Hands in training in diagnostic upper GI Endoscopy" in Medicine & Collection, Storage and Transport of patient sample in Paramedical Sciences for approval of Academic Council.
- All the proposals were passed in the meeting that will be sent to next Academic Council meeting.
