Admission of MJMC for Lateral Entry.

- Courses based on Employability, Skill Development and other Value Added Courses will be implemented on the basic of Choice Based Credit
- Designing the curricula for adapting the BJMC/MJMC syllabus as per CBCS pattern for the commig session 2018-19
- Designing the syllabus of PG Diploma Courses (Development Journalism & Advertising Public Relation and corporate communication)

- In view of regular calling of the students from cities like Delhi, Lucknow, Ghaziabad, Chandigarh, Jaipur, Saharanpur etc. for lateral entry admission in MJMC (Master of Journalism and Mass Communication), BoS has passed resolution to start lateral entry admission in MJMC under the following conditions.
 - Post Graduate Diploma in Journalism and Mass Communication from any recognized Institute/University. (i)
 - Age bar as per SVSU Rules. (ii)
 - (iii) 70% syllabus should be matching with MJMC Program.
 - Migration Certificate (Graduation) to be submitted at the time of admission. (iv)
- As decided in last Board of Studies ,in view of Choice Based Credit following subjects have been added in the curriculum on the basis of skill enhancement /employability and entrepreneurship.
 - Media Writing and Practices.
 - Photo Journalism.
 - Script Writing. (iii)
 - Web Journalism. (iv)
 - Media Agencies.
 - (vi) Design and Graphics.
 - (vii) T.V. Production.
 - Radio Production (viii)

It was also decided that as per the demand of Industry following Value Added Courses should be a part of curriculum to enhance the quality of outcome base learning.
