The meeting was started with the welcome address of Principal & Dean Dr. A.K. Srivastava. It begins with the confirmation of minutes of previous Faculty Board meeting



dated 22.11.2020. Dr. Srivastava informed the house that though the Competency Based MBBS Curriculum is approved by Academic Council, the date-wise syllabus of 2<sup>nd</sup> year was discussed in curriculum committee and approved by Nodal center of NMC at HIMS, Jolly Grant, Dehradun (Annexure No.1).

The second year is of 11 month with total 1440 hours teaching in Pathology, Pharmacology, Microbiology, Community Medicine, Forensic Medicine, AETCOM etc. Hospital posting started in 12 clinical subjects including Community Medicine.

The plan of examination, distribution of marks and generation of mark sheet is different in second MBBS examination, so an approval from Academic Council is required. The plan of examination is as:

- Dean Academics, Dr. Satyam Khare informed the house that the students will be examined only in Pathology, Microbiology & Pharmacology at the end of second year, after 11 months. HoD-Pathology, Microbiology & Pharmacology seconded the proposal. The HoD-Pharmacology, Dr. Surbhi Gupta inform the house that:-
  - (a) The theory portion of Pathology, Microbiology & Pharmacology is of 200 marks with two papers, each of 100 marks. The division of syllabus in these subjects in paper 1 & 2 is attached as Annexure No.2 (A).
  - (b) Each paper will contain 20 MCQ's each of one marks and AETCOM for 5 marks.
  - (c) Viva (oral) is the part of practical examination.
  - (d) Practical (including viva) is of 100 marks.
  - Internal Assessment: Marks of Internal Assessment will not to be added in the marks of University examination. Now they are the eligibility criteria to appear in University examination. 50% of internal assessment (theory & practical) is mandatory to appear in University examination.
  - 3. Marks sheet: It is redesigned as per the new requirement: (Annexure No.2B)

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### Action Taken Report for the Faculty Board Meeting held on 27/05/2021

- 1. The Academic Council, SVSU passed the following proposals:
  - a. The 2<sup>nd</sup> Professional University examination will be in subjects of Pathology, Microbiology and Pharmacology after 9 months.
  - b. The theory examination of above subjects will be 2 papers of 100 marks each.
  - c. Viva will be a part of practical examination.
  - d. Practical examination will be of 100 marks.
  - e. Internal assessment will not be added in the marks of University examination, they will be the eligibility criteria to appear in University examination.
  - f. 50% of internal assessment will be the only eligibility Criteria for appearing in the examination.
  - g. The division of syllabus was also approved for above subjects.
