

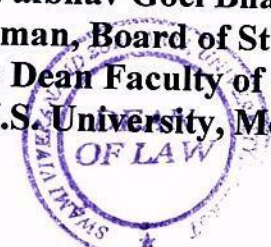

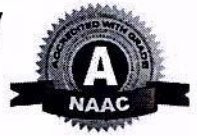

2	To discuss the applicability of National Education Policy 2020 on Law Courses.	<p>Though as on date NEP-2020 is not applicable on Law and Medicine, still discussion held on the issue and all the faculty put their opinion one by one and at the end reached on the conclusion that directly the law discipline is not included in the NEP-2020 but various law courses have been made optional for other discipline like Arts & Humanities etc to have interdisciplinary approach. Therefore while finalizing the course outline by such disciplines; one legal expert should be invited. Even during NAAC visit 2016 this was the observation of the peer team that 'one subject expert must be in the committee while course designing regardless the issue who teaches the subject'.</p> <p>It was further pointed out that Law program is functional under BCI guidelines hence we should also wait for the same. To critical analyses the future of legal education under NEP-2020 one National Webinar also organized where Dean-Faculty of Law Lucknow, University, Director-P.G. Legal Studies, D.B.R.A. Central University & to experts from U.P. steering committee for the execution of NEP in U.P., given their scholarly opinion. Their opinion was identical. Hence, all the members unanimously agreed and accepted.</p>	Forward to the Registrar for information and for the needful.
3	To discuss the permissible limit of online classes	With the permission of the chair, discussion held that during this pandemic situation no other option left except online classes. It was briefed by all the faculty members that more than 40% syllabus is covered through online teaching learning method during the session. It is accepted and agreed by all the members.</p>	
4	To discuss the even semester sessional examination mode.	<p>This was briefed by the Academic Coordinator that most of the faculty members have completed about 50% of their syllabus hence first internal assessment (10 marks) should be completed. It was suggested that first internal assessment may be through online mode and assessment. This was agreed because of the need of the time and it was decided that this 10 marks should be divided into three heads i.e. 2 marks for student regularity in online classes, 6 marks of online MCQ/short answer type/written assignment assessment and 2 marks for the behavior and personality development.</p> <p>All members were agreed and accepted the same.</p>	<p>Action to taking by the faculty members, examination coordinator and academic coordinator.</p>
