FUNCTIONS OF THE DISASTER MANAGEMENT COMMITTEE (DMC)

1. Planning and Preparedness

- Formulate and periodically update the College Disaster Management Plan (CDMP).
- Identify potential hazards (fire, chemical accidents, structural collapse, earthquake, flood, etc.) within the campus.
- Conduct risk and vulnerability assessments of college infrastructure, laboratories, and hostels.
- Ensure availability and maintenance of safety equipment such as fire extinguishers, first aid kits, and emergency lighting.
- Develop standard operating procedures (SOPs) for various emergencies.

2. Awareness and Training

- Organize awareness programs, workshops, and drills for students, faculty, and staff on disaster preparedness and response.
- Conduct mock drills (fire, earthquake, evacuation, etc.) at regular intervals.




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- Provide training in first aid, rescue operations, and firefighting to staff and student volunteers.
- 3. Coordination and Communication**
 - Act as the central coordinating body during any emergency or disaster situation.
 - Maintain a communication chain for quick dissemination of information during emergencies.
 - Coordinate with local authorities, such as fire services, police, hospitals, and disaster response agencies (NDRF, SDRF, etc.).
 - Ensure emergency contact numbers are displayed and accessible across the campus.
- 4. Emergency Response**
 - Ensure immediate activation of the emergency plan when a disaster occurs.
 - Supervise evacuation procedures and guide students and staff to designated safe zones.
 - Arrange for first aid and medical assistance to affected persons.
 - Maintain records of affected persons, damages, and response measures.
- 5. Recovery and Rehabilitation**
 - Assess post-disaster damage to infrastructure and resources.
 - Recommend restoration and repair measures for resuming normal academic activities.
 - Provide psychological support and counseling to affected individuals.
 - Prepare and submit a post-disaster report for future improvement in response mechanisms.
- 6. Documentation and Review**
 - Maintain a log of incidents, mock drills, and training sessions.
 - Periodically review the effectiveness of disaster management strategies.
 - Suggest preventive and corrective actions for minimizing future risks.
