Strengthening Alumni Relations

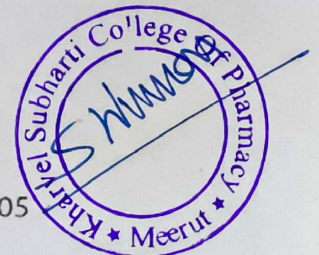
- **Networking Opportunities:** Alumni committees create platforms for networking, allowing former students to connect with each other and current students, which can lead to mentorship and job opportunities.

6. In-Kind Support

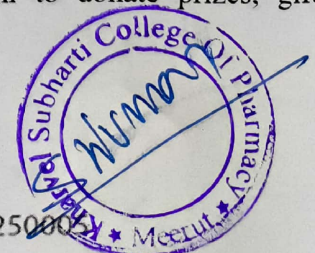
- **Venue and Equipment:** Negotiate with the college for venue sponsorship.
