	<p>Resolution: The Registrar briefed the House that the University Grants Commission (UGC) has notified new regulations to address caste-based discrimination in higher education institutions (HEIs), replacing the 2012 anti-discrimination regulations. The final rules correct major gaps in the draft version by including OBCs, strengthening enforcement, and removing the controversial penalty for "false complaints". 1. Expanded Coverage of Caste-Based Discrimination: Discrimination now explicitly covers SCs, STs, and OBCs. This corrects a major omission in the draft rules, which had excluded OBCs. Aligns with Article 15(4) and 15(5) of the Constitution. 2. Broader Definition of Discrimination: Discrimination includes: Any unfair, biased, or differential treatment (explicit or implicit) Based on caste, religion, race, gender, place of birth, disability. 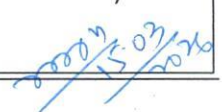

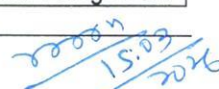
