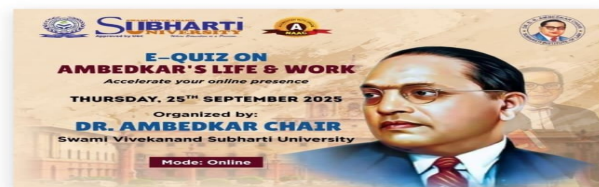
ANALYSIS OF FEEDBACK

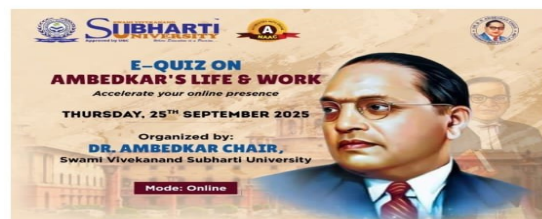
