In comparison, three teams presented arguments from the Anti side, emphasizing the importance and global recognition of the name "India." The participants demonstrated remarkable enthusiasm, confidence, and preparation. Their arguments reflected a deep understanding of Article 1, Clause 1, which states, "India, that is Bharat, shall be a Union of States," and explored its historical, cultural, political, and legal implications.

The programme commenced with a formal inauguration and a warm welcome of the esteemed judges, **Dr. Danish Nouman**, Associate Professor, and **Dr. Saroj Kamboj**, Associate Professor. As a token of respect and gratitude, planters were presented to the judges. In their introductory remarks, the judges appreciated the institution's initiative to commemorate the Constitution's 75th year through academic and intellectual activities.

During the competition, each team was allotted equal time to present their arguments, followed by rebuttal rounds that made the debate lively and intellectually stimulating. The Pro teams highlighted the cultural heritage, historical roots, and indigenous identity associated with the name "Bharat." Conversely, the Anti teams emphasized constitutional continuity, international identity, and diplomatic recognition linked with the name "India." The discussion remained healthy, respectful, and focused on constitutional values.

After careful evaluation based on content, clarity, confidence, logical reasoning, and overall presentation, the judges declared the results.

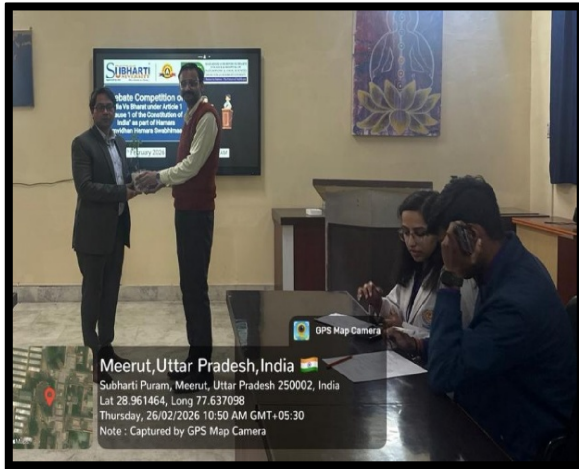
- **First Position:** Team C (Deepak, Harshita)
