3. The post will be for a period of five years, or as may be specified, provided that the Dean Academics may be re-appointed for further term(s) as decided by the Executive Council.
4. The Dean Academics shall be a Professor with at least 10 years' experience as a Professor and a distinguished academic record.
5. The Dean Academic shall;
 - a. Assist the Vice Chancellor in keeping a close watch on academic activities undertaken by the Faculty, Constituent Colleges and Departments of the University.
 - b. Ensure that the decisions/resolutions of the Academic Council are followed in letter and spirit;
 - c. Advise the Vice Chancellor on the updating of curriculum, in accordance with the demand of industry and at par with the one being followed by an institution of repute; and
 - d. Scrutinize the academic proposals emanating from the Colleges/ Departments before these are forwarded for consideration of the Vice Chancellor or the Academic Council.

I. ADDITION OF PARA 5(I) FOR CREATION OF POST OF DEAN RESEARCH & DEVELOPMENT (R&D) .

5(I): DEAN RESEARCH & DEVELOPMENT: Appointment, Powers and Functions

1. The Dean R&D shall be appointed by the Vice Chancellor, on the recommendation of a 3-member committee.
2. The committee will be chaired by the Vice Chancellor and will consist of the Pro Vice Chancellor and a Chancellor's nominee from within or outside the University,
3. The post will be for a period of five years, or as may be specified, provided that the Dean R&D may be re-appointed for further term(s) as decided by the Executive Council.
4. The Dean R&D may be a person with 20 years of teaching and/or research experience, or with 20 years of research experience, with a distinguished profile.
5. The Dean Research & Development shall;
 - a. Work to facilitate and promote quality research in the university and recognized research centre's / laboratories.
 - b. Be the ex-officio secretary of the Research Advisory Board and as such will give effect to its decisions;
 - c. Be overall in-charge of the PhD programme and shall ensure that the overall quality of PhD research is maintained.
 - d. Shall coordinate, supervise, and recommend to the Vice-Chancellor for the approval of the admission of students to PhD. / D.Sc. / D.Lit. / DLL/PDF/ any other research programmes in various faculties as per the eligibility, and entrance exam results, vacancy availability.
 - e. Help the faculty members in the formulation of research projects and submission of proposals for Extra-mural research grants to various bodies and the industry; and
 - f. Mobilize funds for research

II. ADDITION OF PARA 5(J) FOR CREATION OF POST OF ADDITIONAL PRO VICE CHANCELLOR (Addl. PVC)

5(J): ADDITIONAL PRO VICE CHANCELLOR: Appointment, Powers And Functions

1. The Vice Chancellor may appoint Additional Pro Vice-Chancellors to assist him/her in performing his /her duties, with the consent of the Governing Body.
2. The Additional Pro-Vice-Chancellor(s) may be person(s) who have more than ten years' teaching, research, or relevant industry experience, provided that such teaching/industry experience is recognized under the applicable UGC Regulations/ any statutory body.

3. To fix the conduct Executive Council meeting twice in a year mainly in month of Apr and Oct, so that timely action on Academic council meetings can be taken. Next meeting should be planned in Oct 26. In continuation of the same the academic council meetings should take place atleast in March and September so that timely action can be taken by the Executive council.
4. To check financial viability of raised courses / programmes.
5. To review the remuneration of External Examiner/ Visiting Faculty/ Guest Speaker invited at university. Hon'ble VC to constitute a committee to suggest modifications as per market trend.
6. To carry out internal audit / cost benefit analysis mainly for Hostel Fee and Security Fee, 37(41).
7. Analysis of low admission programs and reviewing the seats accordingly for any program including B.A. B.Ed. programme (ITEP). Also, validate financial viability of running program.

Before offering vote of thanks, the Executive Council was of the opinion that University should emphasizes on developing some center of excellence which will give identity to the University at national and international level and unnecessary expansions of courses should be stopped.

The chairman agreed that the above suggestions were well taken for implementation. The Hon'ble members also appreciated the efforts made by the University Administration in the development of the University.

The meeting ended with a vote of thanks to the Chair.
